AN ACT TO MAKE SPECIAL PROVISION DECLARING THE EXPORT DUTY LEVIABLE ON COCONUT OIL AND DESICCATED COCONUT BETWEEN DECEMBER 9, 1951, AND DECEMBER 23, 1951.

[Date of Assent: March 24, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Export Duties (Special Provisions) Act, No. 20 of 1952.

Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in any other law, it is hereby declared that, during the period commencing at midnight of December 9/10, 1951, and ending at midnight of December 23/24, 1951, export duty on coconut oil and desiccated coconut shall be deemed for all purposes to have been duly levied and payable at the rates determined under the Order under the Revenue Protection Ordinance published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,329 of December 8, 1951; and accordingly, nothing in section 4 of that Ordinance shall apply in relation to any export duty levied and paid during that period at the rates aforesaid.
