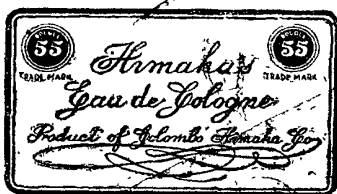

"A direct reading transmission dynamometer".

Abstract.—This invention relates to an apparatus for the determination of the power of a prime mover.

The invention takes advantage of two electrical characteristics of the simple dynamo namely,

(a) the voltage generated by a simple dynamo is proportional to the speed.

(b) the voltage generated by a simple dynamo is also proportional to the angular displacement of the current collecting brushes, provided however that care is taken that the magnetic field is even and free from distortion.

The torque in a given shaft transmitting power is proportional to the torsion in the shaft. This torsion can be magnified by means of levers, cams, gears and like mechanical devices and can be linked to the current collector brush carrying rocker gear whereby the brushes will be moved forward or backward accordingly and vary the voltage caused by the rotational action of the armature in the magnetic field.

The dynamometer comprises a torsion meter, mechanical or electrical, an electrical tachometer with rotatable brush gear, a mechanical or electromagnetic coupling by which the brushes of the tachometer are automatically controlled in proportion to the extent of the torsion in the torsion meter and a volt meter calibrated in units of horsepower.

"Control organ preferably serving as aiming device for firearms".

Abstract.—This invention relates to a control organ serving as an aiming device for firearms.

This control organ is moveable in two planes. It is characterised by a frame (e.g., in the form of the letter H) rotationally supported in a supporting organ which can be rotated in a preferably fixed holder organ. The control organ has supports for resting of a man's arms.

The supporting organ is preferably in the form of a head in which an organ is arranged for the remote transmission of the angular position of the frame in the said head.

The centering organs are so formed as to always strive to hold the head in a predetermined position and that all turning of the head is against the action of one of these organs. The Organ for the remote transmission in the said head influences the means which elevate the barrel of the firearm.

Abstract.—This invention relates to devices for aiming of firearms and is characterized by the devices for aiming laterally being constituted in such a way that at a change of the acting control organ the devices rotate control the firearm and by the devices for aiming vertically being constituted in such a way that at a change of the acting control organ the devices amount control the firearm.
