NOTICE TO EXPORTERS NO. 14—TRANSHIPMENT CARGO

NOTICE to Exporters No. 6 and Export Control Notice No. 15/51 are hereby cancelled.

All transshipment cargo is subject to Export and Exchange licences. Agents/Shippers are advised to apply for licences well ahead of the date of arrival of the goods.

Transshipment Cargo excluding Gold and Overlanded Cargo

All applications to the Principal Collector of Customs to deposit cargo (excluding gold and overlanded cargo) in the transshipment warehouse should first be produced at the Exchange Control Department. Every application should be accompanied by an application on form Q for the issue of an Export licence and supported by one or more of the following documents:—

- Licences issued by the Exchange Control authority in the country of origin of the goods (if within the Sterling Area) showing the country of ultimate destination.
- Bill of Lading or Ship's manifest (preferably stamped by the Customs or Exchange Control authority in the country of export) showing the country of ultimate destination.

2. The Controller of Exports will deal with applications for Export licences in the case of *cargo which is manifested for Colombo*, and the P. C. C. will deal with cargo which is not manifested for Colombo, whether for re-export or for transshipment from one ship in the harbour to another.

3. The signature and stamp of the Deputy Controller of Exchange on the deposit application will be the Exchange Control authority for the transshipment of the cargo.

4. If the Deputy Controller of Exchange is unable to authorize transshipment due to lack of documentary support or for any other reason, the deposit application will be stamped "Deposit may be allowed, Shipment to be allowed only on form 'H'" and this will enable the deposit of the cargo in the transshipment warehouse, but re-shipment will not be possible without the production of a licence on form H from the Exchange Control Department.

Overlanded Cargo

Deposit applications in respect of overlanded cargo (excluding gold) supported by a certificate from the Shipping Agents to the effect that the cargo is overlanded should henceforth be made to the P. C. C., who will at his discretion allow the deposit and subsequent transshipment.

Gold

Before any gold coin or bullion is brought into Ceylon, whether for local use or for transshipment, or in transit, to a place outside Ceylon, an *import licence must be obtained beforehand*. Failure to

obtain an import licence beforehand by the person or persons responsible for bringing the gold into the Island will result in the gold being subject to forfeiture under the Customs Ordinance.

Export of Passengers' Baggage, Accompanied or Unaccompanied

Residents leaving Ceylon on holiday for any destination and those leaving for permanent residence within the Sterling Area. Personal and household effects do not require an export licence from the Export or Exchange Control Departments.

Residents leaving Ceylon for permanent residence outside the Sterling Area.

In the case of accompanied personal and household effects, no export licence is required from the Export Control Department, but a licence from the Exchange Control Department is necessary. When the baggage is unaccompanied, export licences from both Controls are required.

2. In the case of unaccompanied baggage of persons leaving Ceylon for permanent residence within the Sterling Area, a Declaration on the Customs specification form should be made by the shipper that the owner is proceeding for permanent residence to a country within the Sterling Area.

3. The P. C. C. will exercise his discretion as regards the goods which come within the definition of passengers' "baggage".

Southern Limit.—A line drawn from a point (B) situated 165.5° one nautical mile from the Flagstaff marked near Galbokka point in a direction of 270° for 3 nautical miles.

Western Limit.—A line joining the Western extremities of the above-mentioned Northern and Southern limits.

Eastern Limit.—A line drawn from the point (A) above-mentioned in a direction 180° for a distance of 0.6 nautical mile, thence in a direction 206° to meet the sea coast at high water mark, thence following the high water mark to the point (B) above-mentioned.

High Water Mark.—The high water mark referred to in the Eastern Limit above means a horizontal distance of 6 feet inland from the position which the sea reaches at Mean High Water Spring Tides.
