REGULATION made by the Minister of Defence and External Affairs under section 155 of the Army Act, No. 17 of 1949.

## REGULATION

The regulations cited as the Army Pay Code and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,028 of October 10, 1949, as amended by regulation published in *Gazette* No. 10,228 of March 30, 1951, are hereby further amended as follows:—

(1) in regulation 3, by the substitution, for the words "Defence Force Ordinance.", in paragraph (1) thereof, of the following:—

"Defence Force Ordinance:

Provided however that, in the case of service referred to in clause (b) of this paragraph, any period of service in a temporary rank shall not be reckoned for the purposes of increments of pay unless such rank has subsequently been confirmed.";

(2) in paragraph (6) of regulation 7—

(a) in the definition of "reckonable former service"—

(i) by the substitution, for the words "misconduct; and" in clause (ii) of sub-paragraph (d) thereof, of the word "misconduct"; and

(ii) by the insertion immediately after clause (iii) of that sub-paragraph, of the following new clauses:—

"(iv) any continuous period of service exceeding twenty-eight days during which pay has been forfeited; and

(v) any period of service forfeited by reason of desertion or fraudulent enlistment unless such service has been restored in accordance with the regulations in force at the time.";

(b) in the definition of "service in the rank"—

(i) by the substitution, for the words "reduced, and" in sub-paragraph (a) of the word "reduced," and

(ii) by the insertion immediately after sub-paragraph (b), of the following new sub-paragraph:—

"(c) where he has served in a temporary rank which has not been subsequently confirmed.";

(3) by the substitution for regulation 8 thereof, of the following new regulation:—

"8. The pay to which a soldier is entitled in respect of any month shall be issued to him in two instalments.";

(4) in regulation 19, by the substitution for paragraph (2) thereof, of the following new paragraph:—

"(2) The children referred to in paragraph (1) of this regulation shall be—

(a) children below the age of eighteen years who are receiving full time education, or

(b) children irrespective of age, who are prevented from contributing to their own maintenance by an infirmity which arose while they were children for the maintenance of whom a marriage allowance was issuable.";

(5) in regulation 20, by the insertion immediately after paragraph (4) thereof, of the following new paragraph.—

"(5) The marriage allowance of any officer or soldier shall not be issuable during any period when such officer or soldier is absent without leave.";

(6) by the substitution for regulation 23 of the following new regulation:—

"23. The marriage allowance to which a soldier is entitled shall be issued to his family on his behalf together with the appropriate qualifying allotment."; and

(7) by the substitution for regulation 24 of the following new regulation:—

"24. (1) Every soldier shall be required, as a condition of the issue of marriage allowance, to agree to a qualifying allotment, according to the following scale, being deducted from his pay and issued with such allowance:—

	Rate per day Rs. c.
Warrant Officer ..	.. 1 33
Staff-Sergeant ..	.. 1 15
Sergeant ..	.. 0 85
Any other soldier ..	.. 0 50

(2) Where a soldier has incurred forfeiture of pay during any period, no qualifying allotment shall be issued to his family in respect of that period.

(3) Where the marriage allowance is paid direct to the guardian of a motherless child at one half of the normal rate, the qualifying allotment shall be at one half of the normal rate."
