#### The Customs Ordinance

Customs Notification (General)

IT is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 19 of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 185), as modified by the Proclamations published in *Gazatte Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, and No. 9,828 of February 5, 1948, the Minister of Finance has been pleased to direct that, with effect from June 13, 1952—

- (1) all duties of Customs, as well as all penalties and forfeitures incurred under that Ordinance, shall be paid and received at the rates of exchange set out in the Schedule hereto; and
- (2) the notification relating to the rates of exchange published in *Gazatte Extraordinary* No. 10,392 of May 8, 1952, is hereby cancelled.
