It is ordered that the above-named 4th respondent be appointed guardian ad hiem over the minors, the 1st, 2nd and 3rd respondents, and that the petitioner be declared entitled to have letters of administration to the estate of the said deceased and the same issued to him, unless the respondents or others interested, shall on or before February 15, 1952, appear before this court and show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary. contrary.

It is further ordered that the petitioner do produce the said minors in court on the said date.
