The Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946

THE following resolution passed by the Village Committee of the Weke village area in the Colombo District, under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, has been approved by the Minister of Health and Local Government and is published in terms of sub-section (2) of that section:—

RESOLUTION

“ This Village Committee, under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, hereby imposes and levies with effect from the date on which this resolution is published in the *Gazette*, a tax at the rates set out hereunder on payments for admission to entertainments (as defined in the Ordinance) held in the area within the administrative limits of the Committee.

Separation of Hikkaduwa, Dodanduwa Town Council Area

(ii) They must be not less than 18 years nor more than 25 years of age on May 30, 1952.

(iii) They should have passed the Senior School Certificate (English) examination or the London Matriculation or a higher examination, with Mathematics as a subject of the examination passed. Preference will be given to candidates who have in addition passed in Physics or Mechanics or Applied Mathematics.

(iv) Ability to converse in Sinhalese and Tamil and to read one of these languages will be an additional qualification.

4. *Conditions of service.*—The selected candidates will be required to carry out such work and duties as may be allotted to them by the Engineer under whom they are placed. They may be required to attend evening classes at the Ceylon Technical College and to follow the Diploma Course (Evening) in Municipal Engineering. On passing the first year sessional examination of the Municipal

Engineering course, they will be promoted to Grade II and placed on the step, Rs. 1,200 in the salary scale for Grade II Overseers. They will receive the next increment on passing the 2nd year sessional and the increment following on obtaining the Diploma. On successful completion of the three year course by obtaining the Diploma in Municipal Engineering (Part-time Evening Course) all Overseers will be eligible for promotion to the Sub-Inspectors' Grade as and when vacancies occur. Overseers who fail to pass the first year sessional examination of the Municipal Engineering Course, will nevertheless, continue to draw salary on the Grade III Overseers' scale, provided their work and conduct, &c., are satisfactory. They will be considered for promotions to Grade II and thereafter to Grade I along with others on the occurrence of vacancies, but they will not be eligible for promotion to the grade of Sub-Inspector.
