#### The Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946

THE following resolution passed by the Moratuwa Urban Council, under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, has been approved by the Minister of Local Government and is published in terms of sub-section (2) of that section:—

#### Resolution

“This Council, under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, hereby imposes and levies, with effect from the date on which resolution is published in the *Gazette*, a tax at the rates set out hereunder on payments for admission to entertainments (as defined in the Ordinance) held in the area within the administrative limits of the Council, in lieu of the tax imposed and levied in respect of such payments by resolution published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,672 of February 26, 1947.

#### ORDER

The limits of the village area of Uda Pattu South, in the Kuruwiti Korale in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Kuruwiti Korale are hereby altered and redefined by the exclusion, from that village area, of the portion specified in the Schedule hereto.

#### Schedule

That portion of the village area of Uda Pattu South, in the Kuruwiti Korale, known as the village of Wefalupe (part) F. V. P. 347, lying within the administrative limits of the Ratnapura Urban Council as defined in the Order under sections 2, 5, 6

and 30 of the Urban Councils Ordinance, No. 61 of 1939, published in *Gazette* No. 9,936 of January 7, 1949, and bounded as follows:—

*North*: By the southern limit of the village of Hidellena, F. V. P. 342 and the western limit of the village of Olugala, F. V. P. 343.

*East*: By the western limit of the village of Olugala, F. V. P. 343, the northern limit of the village of Mihitiya, F. V. P. 345 and the northern and western limits of the village of Godigamuwa, F. V. P. 346.

*South*: By the northern boundary of the administrative limits of the Ratnapura Urban Council as defined in the Order under section 14 of the Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920, published in *Gazette* No. 7,797 of August 8, 1930.

*West*: By the eastern limits of the village of Dewalegawa, F. V. P. 238 and Ketaliyanpalla, F. V. P. 237.
