The Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations

Notification

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Regulation 5A of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, which has the force of law by virtue of the Import and Export Control (Continuation) Act, No. 27 of 1950, I, Gerald Owen Nicholas, Acting Controller of Imports, do hereby amend the Schedule to Open General Licence No. 3, dated September 20, 1951, and published in *Gazette* No. 10,301 of September 28, 1951, (as amended by any subsequent Notification), by the omission of the following items:—

- (1) item 11 relating to margarine; and
- (2) item 15 relating to oils and fats, refined, edible: animal lard.

The Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations

Open General Licence No. 4

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Regulation 5A of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, which has the force of law by virtue of the Import and Export Control (Continuation) Act, No. 27 of 1950, I, Gerald Owen Nicholas, Acting Controller of Imports, do hereby authorise the importation into Ceylon by any person of such goods of any class or description specified in the Schedule hereto as have been grown, produced or manufactured in any territory except the following:—

Austria, Belgium, Luxemburg, Denmark, France, Iceland, Greece, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Japan, Germany, United States of America, any territory under the sovereignty of the United States of America, Philippine Islands, Bolivia, Columbia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Venezuela, Canada and Newfoundland.

The above Open General Licence is issued subject to the condition that nothing therein shall affect or prejudice or be deemed or construed to affect or prejudice, the provisions or requirements of any other written law applicable to any goods to which such Open General Licence refers at the time of the importation of any such goods into Ceylon.

Miscellaneous Departmental Notices

Import Control Notice No. 10/52

(1) The attention of importers is drawn to the Notifications under the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations published in this *Gazette*.

(2) The following items have now been withdrawn from Open General Licence No. 3. A licence is required for their importation from any source.

(3) The items specified in the Schedule below have now been withdrawn from Open General Licence No. 1. A new Open General Licence No. 4 has been published. A licence is now required for the importation of these goods if they are either grown, produced or manufactured in the following countries :—

Austria, Belgium, Luxemburg, Denmark, France, Italy, Iceland, Greece, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Japan, Germany and United States of America and any territory under the sovereignty of the United States of America, Philippine Islands, Bolivia, Columbia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Venezuela, Canada, and Newfoundland.

Importers are requested to forward on or before October 15, 1952, a statement of Outstanding Orders placed and confirmed in respect of the goods specified in the Schedule below from *Austria, Belgium, Luxemburg, Denmark, France, Iceland, Greece, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland, and Turkey* before September 23, 1952, supported by documentary evidence. The c.i.f. value in Rupees should be stated in respect of each Outstanding Order. A separate statement should be forwarded in respect of each item and for each country.

(4) A statement of Outstanding Orders is not required in respect of any of these goods manufactured in Japan.

Ceylonese Registered Importers who have ordered goods from Japan on their General Import Licence or on any individual import licence granted to them are not affected by this amendment to the Regulations. They may continue to order goods from Japan which are covered by their General Import Licences. For other goods they should obtain individual import licences.

(5) As regards orders on Germany placed by Ceylonese Registered Importers who hold General Import Licences, they are informed that these goods can no longer be ordered on their General Import licences. Individual import licences should be obtained for each commodity in future. A statement of Outstanding Orders on Germany placed and confirmed before September 23, 1952, for these items should also be forwarded on or before October 15, 1952.

(6) It should be noted that as regards Dollar Sources these goods are under licence and cannot be ordered unless an import licence has been obtained. The attention of importers is drawn to Import Control Notice No. 7/52 of August 27, 1952, regarding imports from Dollar Sources.
