The Defence (Finance) Regulations

Order under Regulation 5 (1)

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me by regulation 5 (1) of the Defence (Finance) Regulations, having the force of law by virtue of the Exchange and Securities Control (Continuation) Act, No. 35 of 1950, I, Junius Richard Jayewardene, Minister of Finance, do by this Order amend the Order under the aforesaid regulation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,872 of June 1, 1948, as last amended by the Order published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,442 of September 3, 1952, in paragraph (1) thereof, by the substitution, for sub-paragraph (c), of the following new sub-paragraph :—

“(c) the taking out of Ceylon by any person—

- (i) to any part of India, other than Portuguese or French India, of a sum not exceeding Rs. 140 or the equivalent thereof in respect of any one month in currency notes and coin including currency notes and coin issued by the Government of India ; or :
- (ii) to any destination, including Portuguese or French India but excluding any other part of India, of a sum not exceeding Rs. 140 or the equivalent thereof in respect of any one month in currency notes and coin other than currency notes and coin issued by the Government of India. ”
