Rule made under section 7 of the Council of Legal Education Ordinance by the Incorporated Council of Legal Education at a meeting convened for the purpose and held on July 29, 1952.

The following rule, shall be substituted for rule 24 of the rules contained in the Second Schedule to the Courts Ordinance:—

"24. Such admission shall be in the month of August each year; and every candidate who fulfils the requirements of Rule 23 may be registered as a student on paying to the Council the admission fee of Rs. 100. Provided that the Principal may, pending the publication of the results of any examination referred to in Rule 23 which has already been held provisionally admit any person who, being a candidate for such examination, satisfies the other requirements of the said rule and pays the terminal fees, not more than three-fourths of which may be refunded if he fails to pass such examination."
