The Notaries Ordinance

REGULATION made by the Minister of Home Affairs under section 8 of the Notaries Ordinance (Chapter 91), as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947.

REGULATION

The First Schedule to the Notaries Ordinance (Chapter 91), as amended by regulation published in *Gazette* No. 10,082 of March 10, 1950, is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (1) by the substitution, for regulation 1, of the following new regulation:—

“1. Every person intending to be an articulated clerk with a view to qualifying himself for the office of a notary shall be required to sit for a competitive examination. At every such examination the Registrar-General may reserve a specified number of vacancies for persons—

- (a) who are at the date of the examination employed as notaries' clerks, and
(b) who have been so employed for a continuous period of not less than five years immediately preceding the date of the examination”.

- (2) in regulation 2—

- (a) by the substitution, in paragraph (c), for the words “three months old; and” of the words “three months old;”;

- (b) by the substitution, in paragraph (d), for the words “acceptable to the Registrar-General.”, of the words “acceptable to the Registrar-General; and”;

- (c) by the addition, immediately after paragraph (d), of the following new paragraph:—

“(e) in the case of a notary's clerk, be accompanied by a certificate or certificates from the notary or notaries under whom he is employed or has been employed in proof of his eligibility under regulation 1”;

- (3) in regulations 5 and 6, by the substitution, for the expression “Director of Education” wherever that expression occurs in those regulations, of the expression “Commissioner of Examinations”;

- (4) by the insertion immediately after regulation 13, of the following new regulation:—

“14. For the purposes of these regulations, the expression “notary's clerk” means a clerk employed by a notary for the purposes of his professional work as a notary.”;

- (5) in the form set out in the Schedule thereto, by the substitution, for item 7 of the following new item:—

“7. (a) I attach the originals of two testimonials of character and suitability given to me by _____ of _____ and _____ of _____ (marked (B) and (C)).

* (b) I also attach _____ certificate/* certificates from _____ notary/*notaries in proof of my continuous employment as clerk to a notary for a period of five years.”.

WHEAT FLOUR

Food Price Order No. ML.—10.

The Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) Supplementary Provisions No. 2 Regulations, I, Arthur Rajakumar Ratnavale, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for the Matale District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Orders No. ML-8 of October 2, 1950, published in *Government Gazette* No. 10,161 of October 6, 1950, and No. ML-9 of February 14, 1951, published in *Government Gazette* No. 10,215 of February 23, 1951.

- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per 148 pounds nett, 138½ pounds nett, 195 pounds nett and the maximum retail price per pound, above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- (a) the term "wheat flour" shall include any mixture of wheat flour with maize flour;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (c) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell any wheat flour which has been mixed with any other article except maize flour;
- (5) direct that no person shall sell any mixture of wheat flour and maize flour which contains more than five per cent. by weight of maize flour;
- (6) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (7) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any wheat flour by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any wheat flour by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the weight of the wheat flour sold;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, *i.e.*, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

Minute on the Dental Service

The Dental Service consists of two grades the salary scales of which are follows:—

Grade II: Rs. 4,080—10 of 360—7,680 per annum
(2 years' halt on Rs. 7,680 and efficiency bar before promotion).

Grade I: Rs. 8,040—1 of 360 & 2 of 480—Rs. 9,360 per annum.

Grades I and II are on a continuous time scale.

2. The service is open to both males and females. The posts are permanent and pensionable in the case of males but non-pensionable in the case of females. Females will, however, be required to contribute to the Public Service Provident Fund under Ordinance No. 18 of 1942 from the date of their appointment.

3. Vacancies will normally be filled by appointment to Grade II of applicants who have obtained the L.D.S. degree of the University of Ceylon or other recognized or registrable qualifications on two years' probation or trial as the case may be.

4. The officers will be required during the probationary or trial period to pass a departmental examination in—

- (1) Administrative Regulations and Public Service Regulations, &c.
- (2) Financial Regulations. (The Medical Department Financial Section Manual and corresponding Financial Regulations).
- (3) Office Administration & Routine.
- (4) Vernaculars (Oral).

Failure to pass the examination within the probationary or trial period will result in the extinction of the probationary (trial) period.

5. Promotion to Grade I is contingent on a Grade II Officer successfully completing a Post Licentiate Course in Dentistry at the University of Ceylon, or obtaining the L.D.S. qualification of a recognized University in the Commonwealth.

6. Officers in the service will be subject to the P. S. C. Rules, Financial, Administrative and other Regulations of Government in force from time to time.

7. Officers of this service are not normally entitled to private practice.

8. Officers appointed to the Service are liable to serve in any part of the Island.

9. Subject to the exigencies of the Service Medical Officers who have specialized in Dentistry may, if they so desire, be employed as Dental Surgeons.
