"Process for the preparation of Threo-1-P-Nitrophenyl-2-Amino-1, 3-Propanediol"

Abstract.—A process for preparing the threo-1-p-nitro-phenyl-2-amino-1-3-propanediol is discussed. It involves the transformation of N, O-diacylated-1-phenyl-2-amino-1, 3-propanediol to the hydrochloride of the O, O-diacylated derivative by treatment with a dehydrating agent (SOCl₂, PCl₅ or POCl₃ at 0–80°C) in the presence of an inert organic solvent (preferably C₆H₆ or CHCl₃).

This hydrochloride is then nitrated with fuming nitric acid or nitric and sulphuric acid (free from HNO₂) at below 0°C.

The nitration product is then saponified and converted to threo-1-p-nitro-phenyl-2-amino-1-3-propanediol. This is effected either by treating the nitration product directly with water and heating to 60–100°C or by extracting with EtAc at pH 7–8 and subsequent saponification with hot dilute mineral acid.

"Process for preparing threo-1-p-Nitro phenyl-2-Acylamino-1, 3-propanediols"

Abstract.—A process for preparing threo-1-p-nitro-phenyl-2-acylamino-3-acyloxy-propan-1-ols are described.

It involves the conversion of the threo-1-p-nitro-phenyl 2-acylamino-3-acyloxy-propan-1-ols to the corresponding 1:3 diacyloxy-hydrochlorides with gaseous HCl in an anhydrous solvent (MeOH, EtOH, Et₂O, Dioxan, CH₃Co.CH₃, CH₃Co.OH) at 0–30°C. The O-O-diacyl derivative hydrochloride is nitrated (with fuming nitric or nitric and sulphuric acids free from HNO₂) at below 0°C. The product is then subjected to migration of an acyl-group to the N-position and contemporaneous saponification of the other acyl group, by diluting the product, adjusting pH to higher than 8 and maintaining the temperature between 0–40°C and using if required an organic solvent miscible with water.

"Process for preparing the alcohol 1-phenyl-2-Amino-1, 3-Propanediol"

Abstract.—The invention relates to a process for the production of alcohol 1-Phenyl-2-amino-1, 3-propanediol.

According to this invention the conversion of phenylserin to 1-phenyl-2-amino-1, 3-propanediol, through its ethyl ester can be carried out using lithium aluminium hydride in an organic solvent, metallic sodium and alcohol; and hydrogen in the presence of a suitable catalyst such as Raney nickel of copper chromite at high pressure and high temperature.

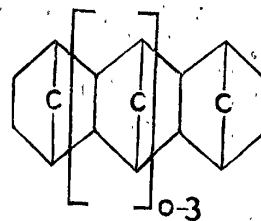

"Methods of preparing insecticidal compositions and the insecticidal composition resulting therefrom"

Abstract.—This invention relates to new compositions of matter possessing high toxicity to insect life.

These new compositions are those possessing the basic carbon skeleton of a series of not more than five linearly fused bicyclo-(2.2.1)-heptane rings, the fusion occurring through the two-carbon atom bridges of the bicyclic rings, to produce a structure containing two terminal five-carbon atom rings. The basic carbon atom skeleton is, therefore, as follows:—



Of the two terminal five membered carbon rings one contains a double bond in the unfused two-carbon atom bridge and bears on its carbon atoms only halogen atoms which, in general, may be of one species only. The halogens thus present are preferably those with atomic numbers lying between 16 and 36 or a range embracing chlorine and bromine. The remaining terminal five membered carbon atom ring contains at least one monovalent component attached to each of the two carbon atoms of the unfused two-carbon atom bridge.

Twenty-three examples and five tables are given as illustration. There are 94 claims.
