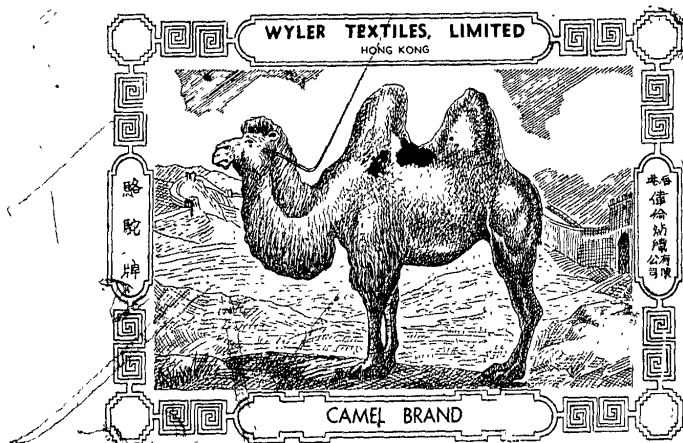

Improvements in weaving coir products "

Abstract — The nature of the invention can be ascertained from the following claims —

1 The making of the crude fibre susceptible to be bleached and also to absorb colours instantaneously and be phable to be woven by treating the fibre in a chemical prepared as described in my patent No. 3,642.

2 The weaving of fibre processed as described above in the form of either tape or braid in different widths and in any lengths for purposes of manufacturing various articles of utility as described

3 The weaving of mats for the floor with either tape or braid woven with coir fibre processed as described in Claim 1 plain and in colours

4 The manufacturing of carpets, chair and bed covers out of woven braid of coir processed as described in Claim 1 and by placing them side by side and parallelly and stitching upon jutesin, canvas or cloth.

5 The flattening of flatly woven articles such as carpets or mats of coir processed as described in Claim 1 in a manner substantially as described in the specification
