"Improvements in non-refillable bottle closures."

Abstract.—This invention which relates to non-refillable bottle closures is of the kind having a ribbed tubular valve casing in the neck of the bottle. The valve casing is formed with an internal valve seat at its lower end on which seats a disc valve seated by a super imposed loose weight movable between the valve and an abutment in the upper part of the tubular valve casing. The valve casing is adapted to fit inside the bottle neck and has an external flange adapted to seat on a washer on the rim of the bottle neck.

There are 6 claims and 1 sheet of drawing
