THE SAVINGS CERTIFICATES ORDINANCE, No. 7 OF 1946

WHEREAS a resolution authorizing a sum of Rs. 10,000,000 to be borrowed within Ceylon by the issue of savings certificates under the Savings Certificates Ordinance, No. 7 of 1946, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, has been passed by the House of Representatives under section 3 of the Ordinance and has been published in *Gazette* No. 10,356 of February 15, 1952:

And whereas the Minister of Finance, has under section 4 (1) of the Ordinance, directed the Postmaster-General to borrow a sum of Rs. 5,000,000 of the said sum of Rs. 10,000,000 by the issue of savings certificates under the Ordinance (in addition to the sum of Rs. 5,000,000 referred to in the notification published in *Gazette* No. 10,379 of April 4, 1952):

REPORT OF THE AUDITOR-GENERAL ON THE ACCOUNTS OF THE SPECIAL AREAS (COLOMBO) DEVELOPMENT BOARD—(1949-50)

THE Balance Sheet as at September 30, 1950, and connected Statements of Account for the year 1949-50 in respect of the Special Areas (Colombo) Development Board have been audited under my direction. I have received all the explanations and information required by me and have certified the Balance Sheet subject to the following observations:—

Income & Expenditure Account

1. *Salaries—Rs. 40,530.85.*—This includes a sum of Rs. 69.68 overpaid as Rent Allowance for the period August 15, 1950, to September 30, 1950, to a Municipal Pensioner employed by the Board. This is only part of the total overpayment of Salary and Rent Allowance to this officer covering the period August 15, 1950, to May 31, 1952, amounting to Rs. 1,134.38. These overpayments occurred as a result of the officer being placed on a more favourable basis of remuneration than had been recommended by the Treasury. This has been attributed to an "oversight" in the office. When I inquired from the Secretary how it was proposed to recover this overpayment, I was informed that the Board had decided to grant covering sanction.

In another case too a sum of Rs. 465.49 was overpaid during the year to an employee of the Board who was a Government Pensioner, who was allowed to draw 2 full cost-of-living allowances for the same period, one as a Government Pensioner and the other as an employee of the Board. The overpayments to this officer from the Board's funds until the matter was put right with effect from July 1, 1952, amounted to Rs. 1,433.62 of which Rs. 465.49 relates to the year 1949-50 under review. In this case too the Board has decided not to make any recoveries in respect of the overpayments.

2. *Government Grant.*—The Grant provided by the Central Government in the Expenditure Estimates—Part IV Loan Fund Expenditure—Vote 6—Ministry of Health and Local Government—Sub-head 13—Grant to the Special Areas (Colombo) Development Board Rs. 1,000,000 was received by the Board only in October, 1950, and has been brought to account under the year 1950-51.

REPORT ON THE WORK DONE BY THE SPECIAL AREAS (COLOMBO) DEVELOPMENT BOARD, DURING THE YEAR 1949-50

DURING the year under review 5 meetings of the Board were held. The following constituted the Board—

The staff of the Board, in addition to the Secretary who was expected to act part-time, comprised of:—

1 Book-keeper (part-time),	3 Peons,
1 Clerk,	1 Cycle orderly,
3 Valuation Inspectors,	1 Labourer.

It was decided that the Public Service Regulations should generally apply to the employees of the Board and any particular question arising should be reviewed by the Board. It was also proposed to draw a Provident Fund Scheme for these employees.

2. Areas 1, 2, 3 and 4 were declared "Special Areas" under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 40 of 1947 under Section 2 thereof. Acquisition proceedings could not be initiated without a survey of the "fire gap" areas as it was necessary to demarcate precise boundaries of the premises that would have to be acquired. The survey of these areas was entrusted to the Surveyor-General at a cost of approximately Rs. 15,000.

The Defence Regulations were due to expire on December 10, 1950, and it was, therefore, resolved that the Government Agent should take possession of the land on the expiry of the Defence Regulations and proceed to pay damage compensation under Rule 2 (1) (b) of the Defence (Compensation) Regulations, and it was also decided that the Board should meet this liability as well as the rent compensation that would be payable under Section 6 (2). The resultant charge of maintenance of the "fire gaps" in a sanitary condition was also accepted by the Board.

Development Schemes for the following areas were prepared and submitted to the Hon'ble Minister, Health and Local Government, and notifications under Section 14 (1) (c) of the Ordinance gazetted:—

A Reclamation Road, Pettah	Gazette of February 17, 1950
B Maradana, Symonds Road, Stanley Place	Gazette of February 17, 1950

3. The Valuation staff were, during this period, almost wholly engaged in collecting material statistics for valuations from the Municipality. As such no claims were paid during the year under Section 2 (1) (b) of the Ordinance as damage compensation.

4. Out of the sum of Rs. 1,944,850 in fixed deposit, it was decided to transfer a sum of Rs. 44,850 together with interest to the Current Account.

Much progress could not have been made during the year under review as the Defence Regulations were still in force and the Civil Defence Department was responsible for the maintenance of "fire gaps" in a sanitary condition and the payment of monthly rent-compensation to owners of "fire gap" properties.
