REGULATION made by the Minister of Defence and External Affairs under section 155 of the Army Act, No. 17 of 1949.

The regulations cited as the Army Pensions and Gratuities Code and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,028 of October 10, 1949, as amended from time to time, are hereby further amended as follows:—

(1) By the insertion immediately after regulation 18A, of the following new regulation:—

“DISABILITY PENSIONS

18B. (1) An annual pension may be awarded in accordance with the scale set out hereunder to an officer in the event of disablement or in respect of an officer in the event of death, where such disablement or death is certified by an Army Medical Board appointed for the purpose, to be attributable to war service, but so however, that the aggregate amount of pension so awarded together with the Army service pension, if any, shall not exceed 50/60ths of the rate of pay per annum.

(c) Where a gratuity has been originally awarded on a disablement of less than twenty per centum in accordance with the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) and the disablement subsequently rises to twenty per centum or exceeds twenty per centum, a pension may be awarded from the date on which the increased disablement occurs in accordance with the rates laid down for disablement of twenty per centum and above, but any gratuity already awarded shall be revised to a reduced proportionate pension for the period commencing on the date following the date of cessation of pay and allowances and terminating on the date from which the new pension shall be payable. Where the total proportionate pension payable for this period falls short of the gratuity already paid, the difference shall be recovered from the new pension payable.

(7) When an officer who is eligible for a pension or gratuity on the ground of disablement unreasonably refuses to undergo an operation or other medical treatment which in the opinion of the medical board is likely to remove wholly or otherwise reduce in degree such disablement, such pension or gratuity may be withheld wholly or in part.

(8) Wounds, injuries or disease which are due to the misconduct of the officer concerned shall not be regarded as attributable to the conditions of service, and no pension or gratuity shall be payable in respect of disablement or death resulting therefrom.

(9) Disablement or death which is due to a wound, injury or disease which is not attributable to conditions of service but which has been aggravated or accelerated thereby shall be regarded as attributable to the conditions of such service.

(10) The pension payable to an officer may be reduced or withheld if such officer recovers partially or wholly from the disablement in respect of which such pension is paid.

(11) The pension payable to the widow of an officer may be withheld if the widow remarries, provided however, that where a pension is so withheld, the pension payable in respect of the children, if any, of such officer may be increased to that payable under paragraph 3 (b).

(12) Pension may be withheld from the widow of an officer—(a) if she has married such officer after he received the wound or injury or contracted the disease from which he died, and

(b) if at the time of the marriage, she knew that the officer was suffering from such disability or disease.

(13) Pension may be withheld from the widow of an officer who at the time of the death of such officer was separated from him, unless—

(1) such officer was at the time of his death contributing to her support, or

(2) such widow was entitled to support under a separation decree, maintenance order, or duly executed deed of separation.

(14) The following provision shall apply in the case of awards in respect of step-children, adopted children and illegitimate children:—

(a) For a step-child, the mother shall have married the officer before he sustained the wound or injury or before he resigned or was relegated to the Regular Reserve on account of the disease, and the child shall have been regularly maintained by the officer up to the date of any award, or up to the date of his death, as the case may be.

(b) For a legally adopted child, the child shall have been adopted by the officer before he sustained the wound or injury, or before he resigned or was relegated to the Regular Reserve on account of the disease, unless the child would, but for the adoption, have qualified for an allowance as a step-child or as an illegitimate child of the officer.

(c) For an illegitimate child, the child shall have been born before or within nine months after the date on which the officer sustained the wound or injury, or the date on which he resigned or was relegated to the Regular Reserve on account of the disease, and the child shall have been regularly maintained by the officer up to the date of any award, or up to the date of his death, as the case may be, or shall have been the subject of a maintenance order in force against the officer at the date of his death.

(15) (a) The award of pension to a parent or parents in respect of a deceased officer may be made only if—

(i) the deceased officer does not leave a widow or legitimate or illegitimate child, step-child or adopted child eligible for a pension; and

(ii) the parent or parents are in pecuniary need, and were either solely dependent on the deceased at the time of his death, or that the father is deceased or incapable of earning his living by reason of age or infirmity.

(b) The pension of a parent who remarries shall cease as from the date of remarriage.

(16) The award to brothers and sisters may be granted only if—

- (a) the deceased did not leave a widow, legitimate or illegitimate child, step-child or adopted child, or parent eligible for a pension; and
 (b) the brothers and sisters were solely dependent on the deceased at the time of his death, and their pecuniary and other circumstances are such as, in the opinion of the Minister, would justify the grant.

(17) (a) The pension payable to a person under any of the preceding provisions relating to disability awards shall be withheld during the period of imprisonment, if such person is convicted by a Court of Law for any offence and sentenced to imprisonment. Payment of pension shall be resumed in full from the date of release from prison except—

- (i) where the conviction was for treason; or
 (ii) where the conviction was for obtaining public money by fraud from the Government when not less than one half of the restored pension shall be withheld until recovery of the amount obtained by fraud has been effected.

(b) In the event, however, of imprisonment of a disabled officer who is in receipt of a pension, a sum not exceeding one-half of his pension may be paid to his wife or children provided he was not convicted for treason.", and

(2) by the insertion immediately after regulation 26, of the following new regulation 26A:—

“DISABILITY PENSIONS

26A. Report

C. L.

By letter dated August 27, 1952, I was appointed by the Commissioner of Labour, under section 3 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950, to take such steps as I consider necessary for the settlement by conciliation of the dispute which had arisen between the Superintendent of Sunnycroft Estate, Waharaka, and the Ceylon Workers' Congress over dismissal of Mariaie and Velu.

The matter was, in fact, broached by the A. C. L., Avissawella, in the first instance and later dealt with at Commissioner's level with a view to arriving at a satisfactory settlement but no headway could be made as the parties could not agree to come to terms on the vital issue which affected the means of livelihood of the dismissed employees.

In pursuance of the appointment conferred on me I held my sittings at Avissawella on 6 dates, viz. October 24, 1952, October 25, 1952, October 29, 1952, November 6, 1952, November 10, 1952, and November 24, 1952, and on September 24, 1952, and December 23, 1952; at Colombo.

Several attempts were made at different stages of the inquiry to bring about an agreed settlement between the two parties but the attempts proved futile.

The parties were represented by Counsel and the following witnesses whom I considered would be able to give material evidence were examined on the incidents leading to the dismissals and other connected matters:—

- (1) S. Iyaccannu, President, Estate Sangan;
- (2) Mr. Perumal, School Master, Sunnycroft Estate;
- (3) Sengamalay, s/o Muthusamy Kg.;
- (4) Velu;
- (5) Mariaie;
- (6) Ramakrishna Nadar;
- (7) S. M. Stephen, Head Clerk, Sunnycroft Estate;
- (8) Morangan, s/o Weerappan;
- (9) Pitchakaran, s/o Kupan;
- (10) Carupiah, s/o Periannan;
- (11) Mr. C. B. Cotton, Superintendent, Sunnycroft Estate.

The Ceylon Estate Employers' Federation took up the cause of the Superintendent against the Ceylon Workers' Congress and the respective parties were represented by Counsel as follows:—

Ceylon Estate Employers' Federation—Mr. M. P. Spencer.

Ceylon Workers' Congress—Mr. S. P. Amerasingham instructed by Mr. S. Kanagaratnam.

Although at first Mr. Spencer was not inclined to lead evidence on behalf of the Ceylon Estate

Employers' Federation as he felt that it was up to the Ceylon Workers' Congress to prove their case, it was agreed that the onus was upon the people who dismissed the workers to show that they had justifiable reasons for doing so.

Accordingly, the proceedings commenced in great earnest and the Counsel for both parties had the opportunity of cross-examining the witnesses. At this stage I must say that the Superintendent of Sunnycroft Estate who gave evidence in this connection was very helpful to us in detailing the procedure he had adopted before the dismissals were effected. In the course of the evidence given by the other witnesses listed above it became evident to me that they were guilty of gross contradictions of facts, but nevertheless I could make up my mind on the salient points of the case in so far as the propriety or otherwise of the dismissals is concerned. According to the evidence given by the Superintendent of Sunnycroft Estate, he had, in fact, conducted a formal inquiry before he decided on the desirability of transferring Velu and Mariaie to Pottakande Division. The summary dismissal notices were apparently served on them as they refused to move to Pottakande. The questions that arose are (a) whether the Superintendent had satisfied himself in proper manner on the point whether or not the transfer was necessitated or warranted by the conduct of the workers or the exigencies of the estate administration; and (b) whether the mere fact of refusal to proceed to Pottakande constituted a valid ground for issuing summary dismissal notices; (c) whether the circumstances of the case do not suggest that there has been disregard of social or natural justice culminating in unfair labour practice.

It would be interesting to narrate the circumstances that led to the conduct of an inquiry by the Superintendent. Rumour was afloat that, illicit arrack was being sold on the estate and this had reached the ears of the Superintendent. He was presumably actuated by an ardent desire to root out all evil on the estate and had even sought the assistance of S. Iyaccannu, President, Estate Sangan, with this end in view, but apparently, no effective steps could be taken to punish the culprits or to improve matters in any other way. It would appear that the Superintendent had gained the impression, possibly through his head clerk Mr. S. M. Stephen that Velu was also in the illicit racket. There was, however, no proper evidence against Velu. February 14, 1952, was the crucial date in the episode which culminated in the dismissal of Velu and Mariaie. On the night of the 14th February according to the evidence given by Ramakrishna Nadar, Rice Dealer, Yatiyantota, and S. N. Perumal, Teacher, Sunnycroft Estate, both of them drank arrack at the latter's residence. Though the evidence supplied by these two persons in regard to their activities on the particular night differ materially on points which are not directly connected with this case, the fact that they consumed arrack is vouched for by both of them. It was revealed in the course of their evidence that the arrack was obtained from Mariaie's house through Ramalingam, son of Mariaie and another school boy called Sengamalay both of whom were at Perumal's house when Ramakrishna Nadar visited the place on that night. Both Ramakrishna Nadar and Perumal corroborate the fact that a ten rupee note was sent through Ramalingam for the purchase of arrack from Mariaie, but no conclusive evidence was available to establish the position that any money was in fact accepted by Mariaie in respect of the quantity of arrack which she seems to have supplied through Ramalingam. As I have stated before, the arrack was consumed by Perumal and Ramakrishna Nadar on the 14th night. A person called Alagirisamy of Sunnycroft Estate staff, who was leaving that estate, having obtained employment elsewhere, also appears to have been in their company at the time. It is fairly clear that the arrack which was consumed at Perumal's

premises was procured from Mariaie, but on the other hand there is no proper evidence to indicate that an illicit sale of arrack had taken place. On the 15th morning, i.e., the day following the date on which Mariaie is alleged to have sold arrack illicitly to Ramakrishna Nadar, the latter appears to have contacted Stephen, head clerk, and given an account of the incidents, which according to him, had taken place the night before with special emphasis on the arrack affair. Thereafter Mr. Stephen took upon himself the responsibility of questioning Perumal too in regard to the occurrences on the 14th night. Later, he appears to have communicated to the Superintendent of the estate that an illicit sale of arrack had occurred at Mariaie's house and that the estate staff were also involved in the matter. An inquiry was then held by the Superintendent as mentioned above. On the submission made by the head clerk Mr. Stephen, the Superintendent apparently considered it necessary to examine the following witnesses only: (1) Ramakrishna Nadar, (2) S. N. Perumal, (3) Alagirisamy, (4) Sengamalay.

It would be relevant to note in this connection that Messrs. Perumal and Alagirisamy were serving on the estate staff while Ramakrishna Nadar was a rice dealer who had connections with the estate and Sengamalay was a school boy who used to attend evening classes at Perumal's place. All these witnesses evidently knew which way the wind was blowing and in as much as they were subject to the influence of the head clerk in one way or another they could be persuaded to do anything in which the head clerk interested himself. I am satisfied that the inquiry resorted to by the Superintendent had been engineered by the head clerk of the estate as he was not well disposed towards Velu. In the course of the inquiry held by me, it was urged by Counsel for the Ceylon Workers' Congress that Mr. Stephen was nursing a grievance against Velu from the time of Mr. Dulling who was the Superintendent before Mr. Cotton. I do not feel that I can reject this submission as baseless as Mr. Stephen gave me the impression in the course of his evidence that he was actuated by malice. It seemed to me that Mr. Cotton, not unnaturally, had placed implicit trust on the head clerk in view of the fact that the latter was occupying a key position on the estate. In the result the head clerk had assumed extraordinary prerogative and tried to manage matters in the way he liked, particularly as Mr. Cotton was comparatively new.

Coming to the dismissed employees Velu and Mariaie (husband and wife), Mr. Cotton, as far as he was concerned, acted in good faith and had given these two persons an opportunity of presenting themselves at the inquiry held by him, but it did not appear to me that the inquiry, apart from being a purely formal one, did conform to the procedural rules usually applied to departmental inquiries where the accused are duly informed of the charges against them in advance and afforded the opportunity of exculpating themselves. The accused is presumed to be innocent in Common Law till the contrary is proved and the usually accepted rules of procedure are of particular relevance where one is confronted as in this case with persons who are not sufficiently literate to appreciate the implications of the charges against them and put up a defence in vindication of their innocence. It is not unusual even to allow accused to be represented by Counsel at the departmental inquiry where the results are likely to prove disastrous or detrimental to his interests. In this case, therefore, I cannot but consider that the inquiry held by the Superintendent was conducted ex-parte and that undue weight has been placed on the evidence of the witnesses who were not acting dispassionately in the matter. The head clerk himself admitted in the course of cross-examination that he believed Ramakrishna Nadar only in so far as his statement relating to the purchase of

arrack from Mariaie was concerned. Other statements of Ramakrishna Nadar in regard to the activities on the 14th night were condemned by him as false. This is significant enough in that it shows that the head clerk was prepared only to accept any statement which would help him to indicate improper conduct on the part of Velu. At the termination of the inquiry the Superintendent came to the conclusion that Velu and Mariaie were guilty of illicit sale of arrack on the estate and made up his mind to transfer them to Pottakanda. His decision was thereafter communicated to Velu and Mariaie, and they were given a week's notice to prepare for the transfer. When the Superintendent's findings were read out and translated to Mariaie and her husband Velu it had been recorded "that Velu expressed a desire to give one month's notice". When the head clerk was examined by me on this point, he after having stated that Velu said "Nadar and the rest have put him into trouble" denied a little later that he made that statement. This shows the man Mr. Stephen enough.

The decision naturally came as a shock to Velu and Mariaie and they expressed their unwillingness to proceed to Pottakanda as directed by the Superintendent. It was submitted by Counsel for the Congress that they acted on advice from the Ceylon Workers' Congress. This reaction was at best a form of passive protest and cannot reasonably be construed as intended to annoy or embarrass the Superintendent in the legitimate discharge of his duties. Admittedly Velu and Mariaie were in a peculiar predicament as their children were attending school in No. 1 Division—a distance of 4 miles from Pottakanda Division—and they themselves had acquired a vested interest in the particular line as they had a very valuable garden which promised a good return for their labours. At this point it would be interesting to note that Velu was a bungalow servant of Mr. Cotton's predecessor and, in fact, had been taken to Pambagama by Mr. Dulling when he went there on transfer. Velu, however, did not remain long with Mr. Dulling as he was anxious to return to Sunnycroft Estate because he could not remain separated from his wife and children. On Mr. Cotton's own admission it was at Mr. Dulling's personal request that the former found a job for Velu at the factory. This clearly shows that Velu had not exhibited any symptoms of misconduct during his career on the estate nor had his wife given cause for any complaint. Velu appears to have joined Sunnycroft Estate in 1930 and as there was evidently no complaint of a serious nature during the time of Mr. Cotton's predecessors it must be presumed that he had served the management faithfully and satisfactorily. I am, therefore, forced to the conclusion that Mr. Cotton would not have come to an adverse decision at the inquiry in relation to the accused had he not been misdirected and misinformed by the head clerk. I found it difficult to understand why the Superintendent did not proceed against Mr. Perumal, the school teacher, if he was satisfied that he was also a party to the illicit transaction where Mariaie acted as seller as it would be natural to expect a high sense of decorum and decency from a person of that status. It is also not known why Ramakrishna Nadar was allowed to have his dealings with the estate even after this incident and in view of Mr. Stephen's evidence before me that Ramakrishna Nadar used to procure arrack for residents on the estate.

I must also place it on record that Mr. Stephen did not impress me as a truthful witness. He made the point in the course of the inquiry that he had made several entries in his diaries in regard to the illicit sales of arrack that were being conducted on the estate for a long time, but when I visited the estate and asked him to produce the diaries for my reference he could not do so as the diaries were not there. I was anxious to see Velu's line garden in the estate with a view to assessing the amount of

produce that could be realised therefrom but the conductor who is Mr. Stephen's brother-in-law, showed me a plot of land which fell far short of what Mariaie claimed to possess.

To sum up, I consider—

(i) that the inquiry held by the Superintendent was wholly vitiated by the improper manner in which the head clerk had planned and prepared the evidence;

(ii) there had been no mis-conduct either on the part of Velu or Mariaie in the exercise of the duties entrusted to them by the Superintendent so as to warrant any disciplinary action;

(iii) the illicit sale of arrack had not been proved against Velu and Mariaie;

(iv) Velu and Mariaie should not be made the scape-goats for what was alleged to be going on illicitly in the estate;

(v) if as has been made out in the course of evidence placed before me illicit sales were being conducted on the estate, the Superintendent as a law-abiding citizen and a responsible individual should have informed the appropriate authorities so that they could take necessary action;

(vi) there has been disregard of social and natural justice in the summary dismissals of Velu and Mariaie.

It is, of course, admitted that transfer of employees is a matter of internal administration and that there should normally be no interference with the management in this regard, but where in any individual case or cases it appears that a transfer is likely to affect adversely the interests of the parties concerned, there would obviously be an instance of disregard of social or natural justice or rather of unfair labour practice.

In so far as Velu and Mariaie are concerned the transfer would have involved them in a serious loss of garden produce and in a grave dislocation of domestic arrangements and schooling aspects.

In all the circumstances of the case I would recommend that the Superintendent, Sunnycroft Estate, should be pleased to re-open the matter and re-instate Velu and Mariaie in good spirit allowing 3 months' wages as partial compensation for loss of earnings already sustained.
