THE following resolution passed by the Village Committee of the Dompe village area in the Colombo District, under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, has been approved by the Minister of Local Government and is published in terms of sub-section (2) of that section:—

#### Resolution

“This Village Committee under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, hereby imposes and levies, with effect from the date on which this resolution is published in the *Gazette*, a tax at the rates set out hereunder on payments for admission to entertainments (as defined in the Ordinance) held in the area within the administrative limits of the Committee.

## By-laws

The by-laws made by the Village Committee of the Dikwella village area, in the Matara District, and published in *Gazette* No. 10,063 of January 13, 1950, are hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the insertion, immediately after by-law 15, of the following new by-laws:—

## CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS

“15A (1) No person shall within the village area—

- (a) erect any new building or wall within a limit of twelve feet from the centre of any village path or within a limit of eighteen feet from the centre of any village road; or
- (b) commence the erection of any building or wall along any village path or road unless written notice of the intention to erect such building or wall has been given to the Chairman at least thirty days before the date on which such erection is intended to be commenced;

(2) Where any person has, in contravention of the provisions of paragraph (1) of this by-law, erected or commenced to erect a new building or wall, the Chairman may be notice in writing served on such person direct him to demolish such building or wall.

(3) Every person on whom a notice is served under paragraph (2) of this by-law, shall within thirty days of the service of such notice demolish or cause to be demolished the building or wall referred to in that notice.”;

(2) in by-law 52, by the addition immediately after item (n) in paragraph (1) of that by-law of the following new items:—

- (o) Keeping of an establishment to manufacture jewellery;
- (p) Keeping of a printing press;
- (q) Keeping of a smithy”;

(3) by the insertion, immediately after by-law 68, of the following new by-laws:—

“68A. No person shall, in any public place, make any obscene writing or any obscene drawing or sing or recite any obscene song or ballad, or do any other act which is likely to outrage public decency.”;

## OFFICER, &amp;c.

68B. The Chairman may authorise in writing any officer or other person, to collect all taxes or fees due to the Committee and to issue printed receipts bearing the facsimile of his signature, and the seal of the Committee.

68C. No person shall wilfully obstruct—

- (a) the Chairman or any other officer of the Committee in the exercise, performance or discharge of any power, duty or function, conferred, imposed or assigned to such Chairman, or officer by or under any of the provision of the Village Communities Ordinance, or of any by-laws made thereunder; or
- (b) any servant or labourer employed by or on behalf of the Committee in the performance of any duty lawfully imposed upon him by the Chairman or any other officer of the Committee.

## LAND AND PROPERTY

68D. (1) No person shall destroy, damage or interfere with the use of any ambalama, madama, open space or place for public recreation.

(2) No person shall destroy, damage or encroach upon any waste or public land vested in, or under the control of the Committee.

## PUBLIC NOTICES

68E. (1) No person shall deface or destroy any notice which is exhibited by order of the Committee.

(2) No person shall wilfully contravene the directions set out in any notice, or remove any notice board, fence, post or barrier or other thing put up by the authority of the Chairman in the execution of any work commenced under any by-law of the Committee.

## By-laws

## OFFENSIVE AND DANGEROUS TRADES

1. (1) The following trades shall be deemed to be offensive trades:—

- (a) Storing cured or dry fish.
- (b) Storing perishable articles of food for the purpose of sale by wholesale.
- (c) Manufacturing compost or artificial manure.
- (d) Curing or manufacturing rubber.
- (e) Manufacturing vinegar.
- (f) Manufacturing soap.
- (g) Keeping a tannery.
- (h) Curing arecanuts.
- (i) Boiling blood or offal.
- (j) Storing hides.
- (k) Storing bones.
- (l) Icing fish.
- (m) Curing planks.
- (n) Smoking or manufacturing rubber sheets or crepe.
- (o) Storing artificial manure or materials used for the preparation of artificial manure in quantity over three bags.

(2) The following trades shall be deemed to be dangerous trades:—

- (a) manufacturing aerated waters.
- (b) Manufacturing or storing copra.
- (c) Any trade in which machinery driven by oil or other fuel or steam or electricity is used.
- (d) Extracting oil by apparatus (excluding chekkus).
- (e) Quarrying cabook, gravel or metal.
- (f) Storing straw.
- (g) Manufacturing desiccated coconut.
- (h) Curing or storing plumbago.
- (i) Digging for lime stones by opening a pit.
- (j) Manufacturing coconut oil by machinery.
- (k) Burning or storing lime.
- (l) Manufacturing or storing fibre.
- (m) Storing cotton wool.
- (n) Manufacturing matches.
- (o) Manufacturing cigars, or beedies.

(3) The following trades shall be deemed to be dangerous and offensive trades:—

- (a) Dyeing fibre.
- (b) Burning bricks and tiles.

2. (1) No person shall carry on any offensive or dangerous trade unless he is the holder of a licence issued in that behalf by the Chairman, on the recommendation of the Medical Officer of Health.

(2) Every licence shall, unless it is cancelled under by-law 12 expire on the thirty-first day of December of the year in respect of which it is issued.

(3) No licence shall be transferable.

3. No person shall be entitled to a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade, unless—

(1) the place at which that trade is to be carried on is approved by the Medical Officer of Health and,

(2) the building to be used for the purpose of that trade, is in conformity with the following requirements:—

- (a) The building must be in good repair, well ventilated, well lighted and provided with adequate drainage and latrine accommodation;
- (b) The roof of such building must be made of some permanent material and the floor must be cemented;
- (c) The eaves of such building must be not less than six feet from the ground;
- (d) Every room in such building must be provided with windows capable of being opened and the area of such windows when opened shall be not less than one-fifteenth of the superficial floor space;
- (e) The walls of every room in such building must be not less than seven feet in height, and must be built of brick stone or cabook;
- (f) The internal surface of such walls, to a height of at least four feet from the floor must be plastered in cement and the rest of the walls must be lime-plastered and lime-washed and,
- (g) The wood work of such building must be oil-painted or lime-washed.

4. (1) If at any time during the period for which a licence has been issued in respect of any offensive or dangerous trade, any building used for the purpose of that trade ceases to conform to the provisions of by-law 3, the Chairman may, on recommendation of the Medical Officer of Health, cause a notice to be served on the licensee requiring him to do before a day to be specified in the notice, all things necessary to make such building conform to such provisions.

(2) No holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade on whom a notice is served under paragraph (1) shall fail to comply with the requirements of such notice within the time specified therein.

5. Any notice under by-law 4 shall be deemed to have been served on the holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade, if it is affixed to the premises at which he carries on that trade or if it is left with any person employed by him in such premises.

6. The holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade shall cause:—

- (a) the floor of every building used for the purpose of such trade to be swept and cleaned daily;
- (b) the walls of every such building to be lime-washed at least once in every twelve months;
- (c) all apparatus, implements and vessels used in such trade to be kept clean;
- (d) all refuse sweepings, and waste and by-products which are not to be subjected to further trade processed to be removed daily in covered receptacles from the premises in which such trade is carried on.

7. No holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade shall pollute or contaminate any well, tank, river, stream, canal, channel, lake or other inland water.

8. No holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade shall carry on such trade in any manner likely to cause a nuisance to, or to be injurious to the health or comfort of persons in the neighbourhood.

9. Every holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade shall cause any offensive vapours, or gases which are emitted in the course of carrying on such trade—

- (a) to be discharged into the external air in such a manner and at such a height as to admit of their diffusion without injurious or offensive effect; or
- (b) to be passed directly through a fire or into a condensing apparatus.

10. It shall be lawful for the Chairman or the Medical Officer of Health or the Sanitary Inspector or any other Officer of the Committee authorised in writing by the Chairman, at all reasonable times to enter upon and inspect any premises at which any offensive or dangerous trade is being carried on; and the licensee or person in charge thereof shall permit such inspection to be made.

11. The holder of a licence to carry on any offensive or dangerous trade shall keep affixed in a conspicuous position in the premises in which such trade is carried on the licence obtained under by-law 2 or where such licence cannot be so affixed cause, a board to be affixed with the licence number and the name of the holder of the licence clearly painted, in a conspicuous place on such premises.

12. It shall be lawful for the Rural Court, in addition to any other punishment that it may impose, to cancel the licence of any licensee convicted twice or oftner of a breach of any of these by-laws relating to offensive or dangerous trade; and the licensee shall not be entitled to any compensation in respect of the cancellation.

13. In these by-laws—

“Chairman” means the Chairman of the Committee;

“Committee” means the Village Committee of the village area; and

“village area” means The Ganatapalata village area in Tumpane in the Kandy District.

#### By-laws

#### TAX ON VEHICLES AND ANIMALS

1. (1) For the purposes of the tax on vehicles and animals levied under section 47 of the Village Communities Ordinance, every person who has possession or custody or control of any vehicle or

animal liable to such tax shall furnish to the Chairman a schedule of particulars relating to such vehicle or animal in such form as may be provided for the purpose by the Committee.

(2) The schedule referred to in paragraph (1) shall be filled up and returned to the Chairman within seven days of its receipt by the person to whom such schedule is delivered.

2. If any person, after having furnished the schedule referred to in by-law 1, acquires, keeps or uses any vehicle or animal, not mentioned in such schedule, he shall, within one month of acquiring or commencing to keep or use such vehicle or animal, notify the Chairman in writing of the fact of such acquisition, and further furnish true and correct information in respect of every such vehicle or animal so acquired, kept or used.

3. Subject to the provisions of section 47 (2) of the Ordinance, every person who has furnished the schedule referred to in by-law 1 shall without further notice be liable, in respect of vehicles or animals entered in such schedule, to pay the tax for the year for which such schedule is furnished and every person who has sent the written notice required by by-law 2 shall be liable to pay the tax on vehicle or animals referred to in such notice for the year in which such vehicles or animals are acquired by him or otherwise came into his possession.

4. Every person who, having furnished the schedule referred to in by-law 1 or the written notice referred to in by-law 2, claims to be exempt under section 47 (3) of the Ordinance from the liability to pay the tax in respect of any vehicle or animal which is entered in or referred to in such schedule or notice shall forthwith give notice in writing to the Chairman of his claim for such exemption specifying the grounds on which such claim is made.

5. The annual tax payable under the provisions of section 47 of the Ordinance shall be paid at the office of the Committee or to any person authorised by the Chairman in writing on or before the thirty-first day of March in each year:

Provided that in any case where the schedule referred to in by-law 1 or the written notice referred to in by-law 2 is furnished to the Chairman after the thirty-first day of March in any year, the tax in respect of each vehicle or animal referred to in such schedule or notice shall be payable within one month of the date on which such schedule or notice is so furnished.

6. On payment of the annual tax by any person, the Chairman shall issue to the person in respect of every vehicle for which such tax is paid, a metal plate with such of the distinguishing letters for vehicles specified in the Schedule hereto as are appropriate to that vehicle and with figures denoting the year for which the plate is issued and the corresponding number in the register of vehicles. Where any such plate, becomes indistinct or defaced by use or otherwise, the owner shall return it to the Chairman and shall be entitled on making a payment of twenty-five cents to receive a fresh plate. The Chairman may, on his being satisfied by affidavit or otherwise that any such plate has been lost or stolen, issue to the owner thereof a fresh plate on the application of such owner and on payment by such owner of fifty cents.

7. The owner or person in charge of every vehicle shall affix the plate referred to in by-law 6 on a conspicuous part of the vehicle in respect of which such plate was issued.

8. It shall be lawful for the Chairman, or any officer authorized by him in writing, to stop and detain any vehicle proceeding on any road or path, for the purpose of inspecting the metal plate required by by-law 7 to be affixed to that vehicle; and the driver or person in charge of any such

vehicle, shall stop the vehicle and permit the Chairman or such officer to make such inspection, and shall render him all such assistance as may be necessary.

9. In these by-laws—

“Chairman” means the Chairman of the Committee;

“Committee” means the Village Committee of the Kanuketiya village area.

- (e) Storing of straw.
- (f) Manufacture of desiccated coconut.
- (g) Curing or storing of plumbago.
- (h) Digging for coral stones by opening a pit.
- (i) Manufacture of coconut oil by machinery.
- (j) Burning or storing of lime.
- (k) Manufacture or storing of fibre.
- (l) Storing of cotton wool.

- (o) Keeping a kerosene oil depot.
- (p) Manufacture of jewellery.
