With reference to the rules of the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce and relative appendices published on pages 1932 et seq of part I of the Ceylon Government Gazette No 8,024 dated December 22, 1933, it is hereby notified that an Annual General Meeting of the Chamber duly convened and held at their 100ms on Friday, March **20**, 1953

- I Bye-Laws & Conditions of sale of tea by Auction Appendix B —With effect*from the sale of January 12, 1953, bye-law No 4 (1) was amended to read
 - "No Tea shall be put up for sale at the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Sale Room except by mem bers of the Colombo Tea Traders' Association as owners or as duly appointed agents acting for and on behalf of the owners'

With effect from the sale of January 12, 1953, Condition of Sale No 2 was amended to read

- "All teas shall be sold by the lot at so much per lb, all export duty and cesses, if any, shall be for and on account of and be payable by the Buyer No less advance than one cent per lb shall be made on any previous bid When a bid is registered in the auction by the Selling Broker the bidder shall have the right to claim the tea at any advance in price, but the original bid shall be binding until noon of the day following the sale unless it is cancelled by mutual agreement between Seller and Buver
- Il Survey Reports & Arbitration Awards Appendix G—The following set of rules, &c, was adopted, with effect from April 1, 1953, in place of the existing regula

Arbitration Awards and Survey and Assessment Reports

RULES RELATING TO ARBITRATORS, SURVEYORS AND ASSESSORS

- 1 The Committee shall, before December 31, in every year, appoint arbitrators, surveyors and assessors for the ensuing year
- 2 (a) The appointment of surveyors and assessors shall be made from among persons in the employ of members of the Chamber, and application for such appointment shall be submitted by the employer of the person concerned
- (b) With effect from April 1, 1953, no person shall be appointed a surveyor or assessor for the first time unless his application is supported by two members (other than his employer) who shall be of not less than five years standing as members of the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce
- (c) The Committee may, in respect of any applica tion, make such enquiries and call for such information as may appear to the Committee to be necessary to ascertain that the person on whose behalf the application is made is competent to carry out the duties of a surveyor
- (d) Notwithstanding anything contained in the preceding provisions of this rule, the Committee may at any time in its discretion, and with or without prior reference to members, appoint any person as a surveyor or assessor whether he be employed by a member or not if it appears to the Committee to be desirable to do so in order to provide adequately for the various types of services required
- 3 Subject to the provisions of the rules 2 (d) and 4, every appointment shall—
- (1) be valid until December 31 of the year for which the appointment is made, and,
 - (n) terminate forthwith on the surveyor or assessor leaving the employ of the member under whom he was employed at the date of his appoint-

- 4 The Committee may, in its absolute discretion, cancel any appointment at any time without ascribing any reason therefor
- 5 (a) The Secretary shall, at the time of appointment of surveyors and assessors, send to each such person a letter of appointment substantially in the Form A in the Schedule hereto
- (b) Every person appointed as a surveyor or a sessor shall upon receipt of the letter of appointment referred to in paragraph (a), sign a declaration substantially in the Form B in the Schedule hereto and send it forthwith to the Secretarys
- 6 The Complettee shall prepare a list of arbitrators, surveyors and assessors approved by it and circulate a printed copy thereof to all the members, and where any appointment is made by the Committee during the course of the year members shall be notified forthwith
- 7 Every surveyor or assessor shall be entitled to act as an arbitration and to make an arbitration award in any matter relating to the class or description of service for which he has been appointed as surveyor or assessor
- 8 (a) Every surveyor or assessor shall, if he agrees to carry out a survey or assessment required, commence the survey or assessment within four working days of receiving the request for making the survey or assessment
- (b) Every survey or assessment report shall specify the date on which the request for the survey or assessment was rederved and the date or dates on which the survey or assessment was made
- (a) No surveyor shall carry out a survey relating to Marine Insurance (Merchandise) unless he has obtained the prior permission of the Insurance Company whose policy covers the goods that are to be surveyed and, if the Insurance Company is not known, the surveyor shall refer the person requiring the survey to Lloyd's Agents (b) Every survey report relating to Marine Insurance (Merchandise) shall state the name of the Insurance

Company whose policy covers the goods and also the fact that the permission of that Company had been obtained

- 10 No surveyor or assessor shall carry out any survey or assessment in respect of any goods in which he or his employer has any interest by way of insurance, owner-ship, agency, commission or in any other manner whatsoever
- 11 Any surveyor or assessor may for the purpose of performing his duties effectively call upon the assistance of any expert whether or not the latter is a surveyor or assessor appointed by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce
- 12 (a) Every survey report shall be signed by the surveyor and shall include the words "Of the Board of appointed by the Ceylon Surveyors for* -----Chamber of Commerce "

(b) Every assessment report shall be signed by the assessor and shall include the words "Of the Board of appointed by the Ceylon Assessors for* Chamber of Commerce "

- (c) Every arbitration award shall be signed by the surveyor or assessor making it and shall include the words "Of the Board of Arbitrators and Surveyors/
 Assessors for appointed by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce "
- 13 Every survey or assessment report and arbitration award shall be in triplicate and shall be forwarded to the Secretary for registration within thirty days of the date on which the request for the survey or assessment was made or the arbitration award was made as the case
- 14 There shall be sent to the Chamber with every arb.tration award, assessment report and survey report (other than a survey report relating to measurements of baled cargo or coconut shipments) a registration fee of Rs 2 50
- 15 Upon the receipt thereof the Secretary shall attest every copy of the surveyor or assessment report and every arbitration award and these shall also be visaed with the stamp of the Chamber The original and a copy shall be returned to the surveyor or assessor and the other copy shall be filed with the Chamber records

III Conditions of sale of rubber between local shippers for shipment on F O B Contract Appendix H The following set of Conditions, &c, was adopted with effect from April 1, 1953, in place of the existing conditions—

Conditions of Sale of Rubber FOB, Colombo

- 1 These conditions of sale shall apply to every contract relating to the sale or purchase of rubber for delivery free on board Colombo, entered into between a local seller and a local buyer, direct or through a broker Every such contract shall be substantially in Form A1 or Form A2 (as the case may be) contained in the Schedule hereto
- 2 Where a contract is entered into through a Bloker, he shall declare in writing the names of the Seller and the Buyer to each other immediately the contract is made, and if the Broker fails to declare the name of either the Seller or the Buyer, the Bloker shall be hable as Principal and shall be bound by all the terms and conditions of the contract
- 3 The Seller shall make delivery Free on Board such approved ocean going vessel as may be nominated by the Buyer, who shall arrange for the vessel to receive the rubber when it is tendered alongside within the period of loading stipulated by the vessel's agents. For the purposes of this condition, an "approved vessel" means a vessel for which there are duly appointed and properly constituted agents in Colombo.
- 4 The Buyer shall provide all such exchange control permits and/or export licences as may be required by the law for the time being in force and he shall have the option to pay, on the Seller's behalf, any export duties, cesses and harbour dues

- 5 The rate of export duty applicable to the transaction shall be specified in the contract and such rate shall be applicable notwithstanding any subsequent fluctuations of the rate of duty. Unless otherwise agreed between the Buyer and the Seller, the rate shall be the rate of export duty in force on the day on which the contract is made.
- 6 The quality and weight of the rubber delivered or tendered as hereinafter provided shall conform to the description in the contract. The Seller shall furnish the Buyer with a guarantee substantially in Form B contained in the Schedule hereto undertaking to indemnity the Buyer for any claim he may receive in respect of quality or weight. No claim under this condition shall be entertained unless it is submitted and substantiated in accordance with the terms and conditions of The Rubber Trade Association of London and/or The Rubber Trade Association of New York standard c & f and/or c if contracts, and the Rules and Bye laws of those associations, whichever is applicable
- 7 The Buyer shall have the option to appoint any surveyor on the Board of Surveyors for Rubber appointed by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce to carry out a survey for quality and weight at the Seller's warehouse and/or at the wharf. If the survey is carried out at the Seller's warehouse, the Seller shall provide all facilities for the Surveyor to examine up to 10% of the bales comprising the shipment, if it is carried out at the wharf the Buyer shall make all the necessary arrangements and all expenses shall be on the Buyer's account. The survey fees shall be paid by the Buyer.
- 8 The carrying out of the survey shall not exempt the Seller from the obligation to furnish a quality and weight guarantee required under condition 6
- 9 If the Buyer exercises the option vested in him to condition 14 to remove the rubber from the Seller's warehouse, or if the Seller makes a tender under condition 17, the Buyer shall arrange for inspection of quality and weight at the Seller's warehouse, for which inspection all facilities shall be provided by the Seller, and upon inspection and removal of the rubber the Seller's responsibility for weight and quality shall cease forthwith and he shall not be required to furnish a quality and weight guarantee
- 10 The rubber shall be packed in bales customary for the type of rubber referred to m the contract and in accordance with such RMA packing specifications as are in force on the date of the contract. The bales shall be marked in accordance with the Buyer's instructions and no marks (other than those required by law and the shipper's 'firm mark') shall appear without his consent, but any slight variation in marks (other than quality marks) shall not invalidate the contract
- 11 The subber shall be available for removal to the whaif not less than 6 working days prior to the last day of the period of delivery stipulated in the contract, or on the last date of delivery stipulated in the contract as the case may be
- 12 The Buyer shall obtain all such authority as may be required by the law for the time being in force to send the rubber to the wharf
- 13 The Buyer shall furnish the Seller with shipping instructions in writing to reach the Seller not less than two clear working days prior to the day on which the rubber is required to be sent to the wharf
- 14 The Buyer shall have the option to take delivery from the Seller's warehouse and the rubber shall be available for inspection and delivery to the Buyer's transport vehicles not less than 6 working days prior to the last day of the period of delivery, or on the last date of delivery, as the case may be, upon the Buyer giving the Seller notice of his intention to remove the rubber, and such notice shall reach the Seller not less than two clear working days before delivery is required
- 15 Ir delivery is effected free on board, the Buyer shall pay the Seller the full value of such delivery calculated at the price specified in the contract against surrender of mate's receipts in respect of the full quantity stated in the shipping instructions together with the quality and weight guarantee Provided, however,

that the Buyer shall have the right to deduct from such payment the export duty calculated at the rate specified in the contract and cess and harbour dues calculated at rates for the time being in force_if such charges have been paid by the Buyer, and provided further that if the mate's receipts produced by the Seller are claused or qualified, the Seller shall furnish an idemnity to the Buyer against any loss or damage which the Buyer might sustain in consequence thereof

16 If the Buyer exercises the option under condition 14 of taking delivery from the Seller's warehouse, payment shall be made before delivery at the price specified in the contract less export duty, calculated at the rate specified in the contract, and less cess, harbour dues, lighterage and cost of transport from the Seller's stores to the wharf, calculated at the rates for the lime being m force

17 If the Buyer fails to take delivery or to furnish shipping instructions in time to enable delivery to be effected (at the latest) one day after the last day for delivery in terms of the contract, then the Seller shall have the option to tender all or part of the quantity of subber specified in the contract within one month little the expiry of the last day for delivery in terms of the contract

18 Every tender shall be substantially in the Form C contained in the Schedule hereto and shall be sent to the Buyer by registered post. The Buyer shall make pay ment against such tender within three working days from the date on which it was posted, at the price specified in the contract less export duty calculated at the rate stipulated in the contract and cess and harbour dues, and the Seller shall, upon receipt of payment, provide the Buyer with a Store Warrant substantially in the Form D contained in the Schedule hereto

19 When the lubber has been tendered and paid for it shall remain in the Seller's warehouse at his risk and expense for a period of fifteen days from the date of tender and shall be available for delivery at any time. If the Buyer fails to furnish shipping instructions within thirteen days, or fails to take delivery within fifteen days, from the date of tender, the Seller shall be entitled to demand the removal of the lubber from his warehouse and to claim warehouse lent at a rate not exceeding Rs. 2 per ton per day upon the expiry of a period of fifteen days after the date of tender. Upon the lemoval by the Buyer of the lubber from the Seller's warehouse, the Seller shall refund to the Buyer the cost of transport to wharf, and lighterage calculated at the rate for the time being in force, less any warehouse lent chargeable by the Seller hereunder.

20 The rubber shall be entuely at the Buyer's risk after the expiry of fifteen days from the date of tender
