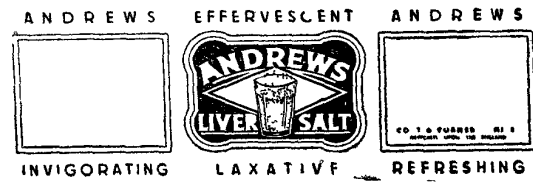

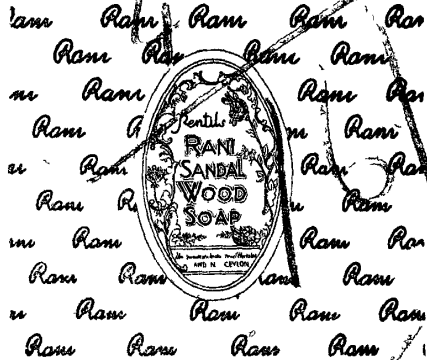

"A machine for filling tobacco in casings for biris"

Abstract—The invention relates to a machine for manufacturing biris

According to this invention the hopper for tobacco is mounted on a rotatable base having a series of openings for the discharge of tobacco, a stationary disc with a chute communicating with a funnel to discharge the tobacco into the biri casing The casing is held by a gripper below the funnel and means are provided for raising and lowering the funnel A poking rod operated by a cam lever which in turn is operated by a series of cam notches provided on a wheel driven by a shaft is placed within the funnel The cam notches are so shaped that the stroke of the poking rod is gradually reduced as tobacco is being filled in the casing

Abstract—This invention relates to a machine for the manufacture of biri casings

The invention comprises a rotatable coiling rod, which is also capable of moving longitudinally along its axis, a carriage with a leaf carrier adapted to feed the leaf to the coiling rod, means for folding one corner of the leaf during folding, means for gripping the leaf on to the coiling rod and for holding the leaf on to the coiling rod when the leaf is being coiled on the rod to form a casing
