

Abstract — The invention relates to a method for producing an improved structural material tor the manufacture of structural units such as blocks, boards, sheets,

Vegetable fibrous material, such as ecconut waste is disintegrated by grinding without addition of water and then subjected to drying so that the moisture content is less than 12 per cent. This material is mixed with a binding agent and thoroughly agitated before passing on to the moulds for pressing and finally for treatment between heated platens. The binding agent may consist of a synthetic resin such as melamine resin or 60 per cent rubbei latex.

"Remote control device with filter network"

Abstract —This invention relates to remote control devices with filter networks especially tor the aiming of frearms. The nature of the invention can be gathered from Claim 1 which reads as follows —

1 A remote control device comprising a controlling and a controlled unit, cash connected to its position indicator, said indicators in competation producing in electric signal, the character of which is dependent on the positions of the controlling and the controlled unit in relation to each other, and which is fed to an amplifier or an amplifier chain containing at least one filter not work, the stgnal obtained from the aplifier or amplifier chain being applied to a device regulating the movements of a driving unit for the controlled unit, characterised by one of the aforesaid filter networks being so designed as to effect a large positive phase shift within a narrow frequency range, whereas the amplitude curve of said filter network shows a moderate increase at high frequencies
