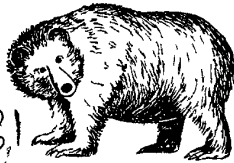

'Improvements in or relating to a method for producing structural units'

Abstract—The invention relates to a method for producing an improved structural material for the manufacture of structural units such as blocks, boards, sheets, &c

Vegetable fibrous material, such as coconut waste is disintegrated by grinding without addition of water and then subjected to drying so that the moisture content is less than 12 per cent This material is mixed with a binding agent and thoroughly agitated before passing on to the moulds for pressing and finally for treatment between heated platens The binding agent may consist of a synthetic resin such as melamine resin or 60 per cent rubber latex

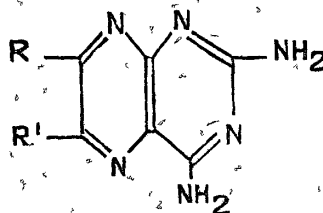

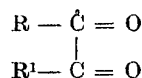
'Improvements in or relating to substituted Pteridines'

Abstract—This invention relates to anti-bacterial substances and more particularly to novel pteridines The novel pteridines according to the invention have the general formula



where R is an ethyl, isopropyl or an aryl radical and R' is an ethyl, isopropyl or an aryl radical

The novel pteridines may be manufactured by condensing by heating 2 4 5 6 tetraaminopyrimidine, its acetate, bisulphite or other salt with α an diketone of the general formula



where R and R' as above. The reaction may be carried out in an acid or an alkaline medium, but for best results an acetic acid medium is used.

Abstract—This invention relates to a method of and apparatus for concentrating ores or the like

According to the invention the mass of particles having different specific gravities is mixed with a liquid and the mixture is caused to flow down as a stream through a helical channel of sufficient length to permit the particles to stratify in the liquid in accordance with their specific gravities and the particles in each of the zones is separately collected and removed from the stream

"Remote control device with filter network"

Abstract—This invention relates to remote control devices with filter networks especially for the arming of firearms. The nature of the invention can be gathered from Claim 1 which reads as follows —

1. A remote control device comprising a controlling and a controlled unit, each connected to its position indicator, said indicators in cooperation producing an electric signal, the character of which is dependent on the positions of the controlling and the controlled unit in relation to each other, and which is fed to an amplifier or an amplifier chain containing at least one filter network, the signal obtained from the amplifier or amplifier chain being applied to a device regulating the movements of a driving unit for the controlled unit, characterized by one of the aforesaid filter networks being so designed as to effect a large positive phase shift within a narrow frequency range, whereas the amplitude curve of said filter network shows a moderate increase at high frequencies
