## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

## MINUTE.

# The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

### An Ordinance to amend "The Masters Attendant's Ordinance, 1865."

HEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain respects

the Ordinance No. 6 of 1865, intituled "An Ördi-

Preamble.

nance to declare the duties of Masters Attendant, and to provide for the better preservation of the Ports of the Island, and for the better regulation of the Shipping therein," and the Ordinance No. 6 of 1880, initialed "An Ordinance for the regulation and government of Boatmen employed in Licensed Boats": It is hereby enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title. To be read as one with Ordinances Nos. 6 of 1865 and 6 of 1880.

Amendment of section 6 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1865.

Amendment of section 23 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1865.

Amendment of section 3 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1880. 1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Masters Attendant's Amendment Ordinance, 189, "and shall be construed and read as one with "The Masters Attendant's Ordinance, 1865," and "The Boatmen's Ordinance, 1880."

2 After sub-section 11 of section 6 of "The Masters Attendant's Ordinance, 1865," there shall be inserted the following sub-section, namely:

11 (a) For regulating bumboats, and all boats used by traders, hawkers, and others for the conveyance of goods for sale in any such port.

3 In section 33 of "The Masters Attendant's Ordinance, 1865," after the words "for the conveyance of hire of passengers" shall be inserted the words "or as a bumboat, or as a boat for the conveyance of traders, hawkers, or of goods for sale."

4 To section 3 of "The Boatmen's Ordinance, 1880," the following words shall be added : "and any bumboat and any boat used by traders or hawkers, or for the conveyance of goods for sale."
