However, in exceptional circumstances, the Deputy Food Controller, Galle, may permit the contractor to employ any non-Ceylonese labourers previously approved by him in writing with the concurrence of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Food. The employment of non-Ceylonese labourers, without such approval and concurrence in writing, is forbidden. The term Ceylonese shall mean—

- (a) a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration;
- (b) a British subject who is born in Ceylon, one of whose parents was born in Ceylon; or
- (c) a British subject who is a descendant of a person falling within category (b).

18. A tenderer who has not previously held Government contracts when applying for tender forms, should furnish the officer issuing the forms

with a written statement giving his full name and permanent address, stating in which district or districts he owns landed property or has other valid interests. The extent of landed property and the nature and extent of other interests should also be given.
