Abstract — This invention relates to the preparation of the substituted amidopropane diol, 2-dichloroacet-amido-1-p-nitrophenylpropane 1 3-diol

The compound is prepared according to the invention by condensing p-nitrobenzaldehyde with dichloroacetaldehyde in the presence of a basic condensing agent and reducing the substituted propanal thus obtained by accepted methods for the reduction of an aldehyde to an alcohol function without effect upon a nitro group.

"Improvements in or relating to the concentration and purification of aqueous colloidal dispersions"

Abstract — This invention relates to a process and apparatus for concurrently concentrating and purifying aqueous colloidal dispersions

According to the invention the process comprises continuously supplying the colloidal dispersion to the space or spaces between a plurality of semi-permeable membranes spaced apart, maintaining an electric potential difference across said membranes, to effect a separation of the dispersion into a colloid rich layer and a colloid impoverished layer separately removing said layers from the space or spaces between said membranes in a continuous manner, and continuously removing dissolved substances from the aqueous dispersion between the membranes by dialysis.

“Compositions comprising biocidal substances, process for combating noxious organisms by means of these compositions and process for preparing the compositions”

Abstract — This invention relates to novel compositions comprising one or more biocidal substances. The invention relates to a process for preparing these compositions the concentrates of which contain —

1. 10 to 75 per cent by weight, preferably 20 to 70 per cent (most preferably 25 to 55 per cent.) by weight of one or more solid substances, at least one of these having biocidal activity

2. 10 to 50 per cent by weight preferably 15 to 30 per cent, by weight of a liquid substantially immiscible with water, has a viscosity at 20° C below 3,000 centipoises preferably below 1,000 centipoises, most preferably below 250 or even below 150 centipoises, which liquid does not solidify above 20° C, preferably not above 10° C, most preferably not above 0° C whilst this liquid does not comprise any components boiling below 50° C ;

3. 0.25 to 25 per cent by weight, preferably 1 to 15 per cent, most preferably 3 to 10 per cent by weight of one or more emulsifying agents.

4. 10 to 40 per cent, by weight, preferably 15 to 20 per cent, by weight of water.
