## Order

The limits of the village area of Weligama situated in Matara District, Southern Province are hereby altered and redefined by the exclusion from that village area, of the portion specified in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

All that area of lands called Orawalawatta and Orawalawatta alias Siddajjakawatta (lots 1 and 2 respectively in P. Plan A 1259), and land called Udumulla claimed by Mrs. S. D. Jayakuru, situated in Walana (part), Matara District, Southern Province, and bounded as follows :—

**North :** By a line drawn from the landmark on the South-Western corner of the land called Ulupattalewatta, (claimed by K. M. James and others), North-Eastwards along the landmarked Southern boundary of the said

land, till it meets the landmark on the Western boundary of the Village Committee Path from Mudugamuwa to Strong's Road, thence South-Eastwards along the said boundary of the said Village Committee Path to the landmark on the North-Western corner of the land called Koraikumbura (claimed by Mrs. S. Jayakuru), thence South-Westwards and Westwards along the Eastern and Southern boundaries of the said land to the landmark on the North-Western corner of premises bearing Assessment No. 1884 (Lokkageammagewatta), thence South-Eastwards along the Western boundary of the said premises till it meets the landmark on its South-Western corner, thence South-Westwards along the Western boundary of premises bearing Assessment No. 1877 (Walauwewatta), till it meets the stone fence at the Northernmost corner, premises bearing Assessment No. 1877 (Udumullagewatta).

*South*: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point South-Westwards along the Western boundary of premises bearing Assessment No. 1896 (Udumullagewatta) to the landmark on its South-Western corner, thence Westwards along the Northern boundaries of the lands called Acharigewatta (claimed by H. A. Charles and others), Koswatta (claimed by H. H. Akolis Appu and others), and Koswatta (claimed by G. V. William Silva and others), to the landmark on the South-Eastern corner of the land called Siddajjakawatta (claimed by Mrs. W. A. Nonis) in Walliwala village

*West*: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point Northwards along the Eastern boundary of the land called Siddajjakawatta in Walliwala village to the starting point of the Northern limit of the area

#### BY-LAW

The by-laws made by the Trincomalee Urban Council and published in *Gazette* No. 8,014 of October 20, 1933, as last amended by by-law published in *Gazette* No. 9,963 of April 1, 1949, are hereby further amended as follows:—

- (1) in by-law 9 by the insertion, for the words and figures "Rs. 50 (rupees fifty)", of the words "two hundred and fifty rupees";
- (2) by the insertion immediately after the by-laws relating to "Icing of fish", of the following new by-laws:—

#### "SALVAGED ARTICLES"

1. No person shall use any premises for storing salvaged articles for the purposes of trade without a licence from the Chairman.

2. No person shall be entitled to a licence to store salvaged articles for the purposes of trade unless the premises are in conformity with the following conditions:—

- (1) The premises must be situated in the area referred to in the schedule hereto.
- (2) The premises must be at least one thousand square feet in extent.
- (3) The premises must be provided with suitable sanitary conveniences for the use of persons employed in the premises.
- (4) No receptacles or articles must be stored in the premises in such a way as to hold rain water or as to facilitate the breeding of mosquitoes.

3. (1) The licensee shall not store any articles of offensive smell in the premises.

(2) The licensee shall cause all refuse and rubbish to be collected in a suitable receptacle and disposed of satisfactorily.

(3) The licensee shall keep the premises in a clean and sanitary condition.

(4) It shall be lawful for the Chairman, the Medical Officer of Health or any Public Health Inspector of the Council to inspect any premises at any time between sunrise and sunset

#### Schedule

The area lying within the administrative limits of Trincomalee Urban Council and bounded as follows:—

*North.*—From a point on the southern boundary of the Anuradhapura Road  $19\frac{1}{4}$  chains north-west of the  $3\frac{1}{4}$  milestone eastwards along

the tarred marked boundary of its junction with Love Lane; thence along the western side of Love Lane as far as its junction with the North Coast Road; thence along the western side of the North Coast Road to a point 37 links south of the 3rd mile stone on the said road and then north-eastwards along the land marked boundary to the sea.

*East.*—From the last-mentioned point southwards along the edge of the sea until it meets the northern boundary of the Hindu Cemetery.

*South.*—From the last-mentioned point southwards along the said boundary until it meets North Coast Road; thence southwards along the eastern boundary of the said road to a point in prolongation of the southern boundary of Railway Approach Road; thence westwards along North Coast Road and westwards and north-westwards along the southern boundary of the Railway Approach Road and Main Street to the junction of Main Street and Inner Harbour Road; thence westwards around Inner Harbour Road to a point on the western boundary of Inner Harbour Road in prolongation of the southern boundary of Main Street.

*West.*—From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western boundary of Inner Harbour Road and across Orr's Hill Road till it meets the limits of the Trincomalee Urban Council and along the said limits to the starting point of the northern boundary.
