Second Schedule

1. The Village Committee of each new village area shall be the successor of the Village Committee of the old village area for all such purposes of the Village Communities Ordinance as may relate to that village area.

2 All by-laws made under the Village Communities Ordinance by the Village Committee of the old village area and in force on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, shall continue in force in each new village area and shall be deemed to have been made by the Village Committee of that new village area.

3. Subject to the provision of paragraph 4 of this Schedule one-half of the amount lying to the credit of the Communal Fund of the Village Committee of the old village area on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, shall, on the first day of July, 1954, be credited to the Communal Fund of the Village Committee of each new village area

4. The unexpended Grants-in-aid allocated to the Village Committee of the old village area in respect of any specified work or works in that area and lying to the credit of the Communal Fund of that village area on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, shall be transferred to the Village Committee of the new village area within which such work or works is or are to be carried out.

5. One-half of all movable property, other than money, vested in, or under the control of, the Village Committee of the old village area on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, shall be deemed to be vested in the Village Committee of each new village area

6. Each land, building or other immovable property vested in, or under the control of, the Village Committee of the old village area on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, shall be deemed to be vested in the Village Committee of the new village area within which such land, building or other immovable property is situated

7 All the rights, debts, liabilities and obligations of the Village Committee of the old village area shall, so far as they relate to any new village area, be deemed to be transferred to the Village Committee of that new village area as from the first day of July, 1954.

8 In this Schedule—

“new village area” means the village area of Velanai or the village area of Narantanai; and

“old village area” means the village area of Valanai.

2. The post carries a salary scale of Rs. 1,440 per annum, rising by annual increments of Rs. 120 to Rs. 3,480 per annum, with an efficiency bar before Rs. 2,640 per annum. 3. Applicants must be Ceylonese* and should be not more than 40 years of age on September 1, 1953, and should have passed the Senior School Certificate Examination (English) or equivalent or higher examination and should possess the certificate of the Ceylon Technical College in Draughtsmanship or a pass in Building Construction with Draughtsmanship as a subject, or 3 years' experience as a Draughtsman in a recognized Engineering firm or Architect's office

4. Applications will also be considered from Clerk-Draughtsmen, Grade II, and officers in similar status in Government or Local Government Service, irrespective of age and educational qualifications.
