# Price Orders

Food Price Order No. CD-RW-4

# THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950 Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4, read with Section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Godfrey Prasad Tambayah, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for the Colombo District, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from October 19, 1953, the Price Order mentioned below in so far as it fixes the maximum prices of Rice for the Colombo District—
  - (a) Food Price Order No CD-RW-3 dated July 16, 1953, published in Government Gazette (Extraordinary) No. 10,552 of July 20, 1953.
- (ii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per 80 measures nett above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule,
- (iii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column I of the same schedule;
- (IV) direct that for the purposes of this Order-
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of any rice for the purpose of resale, or any sale of rice in quantity of 80 measures nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice less than 80 measures nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article,
- (v1) direct that when any rice is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any in which such rice is sold,
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any rice in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area, and
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any rice by Wholesale shall, and every person

who sells rice by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thoreof a receipt in which there shall set out—

- (a) the date of sale,
- (b) the quantity of rice sold;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold, and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, 1 e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

## RICE AND PADDY

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No 29 of 1950, I, Nagamuttu Pulenduan Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), of the Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order-

- (1) revoke with effect from this date price order mentioned below in so far as they fix the maximum prices of nice and paddy for the Nuwara Eliya District-
  - (a) Food Price Order dated July 14, 1953, published in Government Gazette No. 10 551 of July 17, 1953.
- (2) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the first schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price of rice per 80 measures Net and column 3 to be the maximum wholesale price of paddy per 80 measures Net, above which rice and paddy should not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule,
- (3) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the second schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price of rice per measure and column 3 to be the maximum retail price of paddy per measure above which rice and paddy shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the second schedule-
- (4) direct that for the purpose of this order
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy for the purpose of resale, or any sale of rice or paddy in a quantity of 80 measures Net or more at any time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy less than 80 measures Net, for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (5) direct that every trader who sells m the areas mentioned in column 1 of schedules 1 and 2 hereto exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (Store or Boutique) a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this order,

- (6) direct that no person shall sell rice or paddy which is adulterated with any other article,
- (7) direct that every person who sells rice or paddy by wholesale or retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that rice or paddy a receipt in which there shall be set out-
  - (a) the date of the sale,
  - (b) the quantity of rice or paddy sold . and
  - (c) the price paid for the rice or paddy sold,
- (8) direct that for the purpose of this order-
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale, and (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be a standard
  - quart, dry measure.

# THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No 29 of 1950, I, Chandrakirti de Fonseka, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for the District of Polonnaruwa, do by this order—

(i) revoke with effect from October 19, 1953, the Price Order No. PL. 5 dated September 25, 1953, and

- published in the Government Gazette No 10,593 dated October 2, 1953, fixing the maximum prices of paddy within Tamankaduwa District.
- (ii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the first schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per bag of 80 measures nett above which paddy shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule,
- (iii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the second schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which paddy shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule.
- (iv) direct that for the purposes of this Order-
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell any paddy which is adulterated with any other article.
- (vi) direct that when any paddy is sold the maximum price fixed by this order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such paddy is sold
- (vn) direct that every trader who has any paddy in his possession or under his control at any place in any area where the maximum prices are fixed by this Order shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area,
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any paddy by retail shall on demand, and every person who sells any paddy by wholesale shall, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of rice sold,
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of paddy sold;(d) the nature of the transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or retail
