The suppliers' copy of the import licence should be forwarded to the Rubber Commissioner to be retained by him. On arrival of the goods the Rubber Commissioner will endorse the documents in favour of the Importer who placed the order to enable him to pass the necessary Customs entry for the clearance of the goods. The Importer's copy of the licence should be produced to the Customs for the release of the goods”.



### IMPORTS FROM AUSTRIA

Individual Import Licences must be obtained *before any orders are placed* for any goods grown, produced or manufactured in *Austria*.

Ceylonese Registered Importers who hold *valid General Import Licences* will be allowed to import goods for which licences are issued originating from *Austria without any limitation as to quantity or value*.

2. Non-Ceylonese Importers will be allowed to import *only goods of the Category and Item number and description imported by them in 1952, but without limitation as to quantity or value*.

3. The above conditions will *not apply to goods for which ceiling values have been fixed*. Please see "Imports from E. P. U. Sources".

Individual Import Licences must be obtained *before any orders are placed* for any goods grown, produced or manufactured in the *U. S. S. R., Albania, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland and Rumania*.

Ceylonese Registered Importers who hold *valid General Import Licences* will be allowed to import goods for which licences are issued originating from the above sources *without any limitation as to quantity or value*.

2. Non-Ceylonese Importers will be allowed to import *only goods of the category and item number and description imported by them in 1952, but without limitation as to quantity or value*.

### IMPORTS FROM YUGOSLAVIA

Individual Import Licences must be obtained *before any orders are placed* for any goods grown, produced or manufactured in *Yugoslavia*.

Ceylonese Registered Importers who hold *valid General Import Licences* will be allowed to import goods for which licences are issued originating from *Yugoslavia without any limitation as to quantity or value*.

2. Non-Ceylonese Importers will be allowed to import *only goods of the category and item number and description imported by them in 1952, but without limitation as to quantity or value*.
