Notifications of Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court

THE COURTS ORDINANCE

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 28 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6), as modified by the Proclamation under section 88 (1) of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Chollappah Nagalingam, Acting Chief Justice, do, after consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, hereby order that, in addition to the Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court for the Western Circuit which commences at Colombo on the Eleventh day of January, 1954, a Sessions of that Court for that Circuit shall be holden at Kalutara, commencing at such place on the Eleventh day of January, 1954.
