- (b) is not less than 17 and not more than 25 years of age on January 1, 1954.

(c) has passed the Senior School Certificate (English) or equivalent or higher examination.

(d) has a minimum height of 4 ft. 8 inches.

(e) is of good character and of sound constitution and is physically fit to serve in any part of the Island.

3. *Method of application.*—(a) Applications must be made on the specimen form appended below and should be sent under registered cover addressed to "The Director of Health Services, P. O. Box 500, Colombo, and should be marked "Application for selection as Pupil Male Nurses", on the left-hand corner.

(b) Applications should not be addressed personally to the undersigned or to any officer in the Department, nor should they be handed to any officer in this office.

(c) *Originals of certificates or documents should not be attached to the application.* Only copies should be sent and these will not be returned.

(d) The application should be accompanied by—

(i) copy of birth certificate (Baptismal certificate or certificate issued for the purpose of the Code of Regulations for Assisted Schools will not be accepted.)

(ii) copies of educational certificates.

(iii) copies of 2 certificates of character, one of which must be from the Principal of the School or College which the candidate last attended.

4. *Medical examination.*—Selected candidates will be required to undergo a medical examination as to physical fitness to serve as a Nurse in any part of the Island. No candidate will be selected who does not pass the medical examination.

5. *Course of training at the Nurses' Training School.*—(a) The course of training will be for a period of 3 years. The syllabus and scheme of examination will be supplied to eligible candidates.

(b) Pupils whose work and conduct are found unsatisfactory at any time during the period of training will be discontinued.

6. *Appointment as qualified Nurses.*—On the completion of the course of training and passing the Nurses' Final Examination, pupils will be awarded certificates of competency. Government does not undertake to provide all successful candidates with posts immediately after they are awarded certificates of competency, but they will be provided as vacancies occur.

7. *Salary Scale, allowances and conditions of service.*—(a) The present establishment of the Nursing Service with the salary scales and allowances are given below—

Salary scale per annum

Pupil Male Nurses—A subsistence allowance of Rs. 900 per annum for all 3 years.

Nurses—Rs. 1,488—13 of 72—Rs. 2,424.

Allowances

(i) Washing allowance—All grades of the Nursing Service are entitled to Rs. 60 per annum.

(ii) Shoe allowance—Nurses and Pupil Nurses Rs. 20 per annum.

(iii) Free uniforms are issued.

(b) Temporary cost of living allowance and special living allowance will be paid at Government rates.

(c) *Provident Fund*.—The posts are non-pensionable, but candidates will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, the Government contributing 7½ per cent. Candidates will, however, be brought into the Fund only after they are appointed as qualified nurses. The question of making these posts pensionable is under consideration.

(d) The appointment will be subject to Public Service Commission Rules, Financial Regulations, Administrative Regulations, Departmental Orders or Regulations and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

8. Applications that do not conform to any of the requirements specified above will be rejected.
