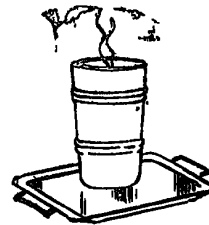

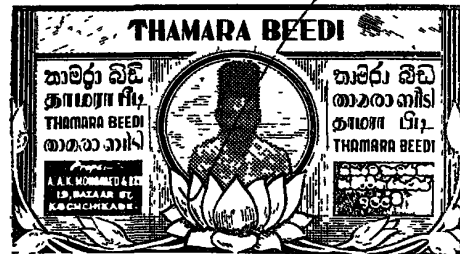

"Improvements in and relating to insecticide spraying machines"

Abstract.—This invention relates to insecticide spraying machines

According to the invention the spraying machine comprises a power unit, a fan unit adapted to be driven by the said power unit and means for feeding insecticide into the air stream of the said fan unit.

All this is supported on a light framework so that it may be moved by hand from place to place. This machine may also be made in two units detachably engageable with one another. One unit comprises the prime mover and the other comprising a fan and means for feeding insecticide.

There are 21 claims and 3 sheets of drawings.

"High protein food product and process for its preparation"

Abstract — This invention relates to a food product. According to the invention the process for preparing synthetic meat includes the steps of preparing a quantity of filaments of protein material (fine or coarse according to requirements) and applying to said filaments an edible binder chosen from the group consisting of cereal binders and edible protein binders.

The method of obtaining the filaments and the manner of treatment of the filaments to simulate given types of meat are described.

There are 27 claims.
