"Improvements in or relating to roofs for storage tanks or similar structures"

*Abstract*—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which is as follows —

A conical roof for a circular structure such as a liquid storage tank which comprises a peripheral curb, a plurality of radially disposed sheet metal panels, together constituting the conical roof surface, which about at their outer ends against the curb, and a centrally disposed crown member to which all the panels are secured at their inner ends, the panels, some at least of which are provided with stiffening flanges, being otherwise unsupported so that they act as half arches with continuity through the crown member
