ORDER

- 1 The area delimited in the First Schedule hereto shall be a town for the purposes of the Urban Councils Ordinance, No 61 of 1939, (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance"), and the administrative limits of that town shall be the limits set out in that Schedule
- 2. The name and designation of the Urban Council to be constituted under the Ordinance for the aforesaid town shall be the following.—
 - "Moratuwa Urban Council".
- 3. The number of members of whom the Moratuwa Urban Council shall consist, shall be twelve.
- 4 The town for which the Moratuwa Urban Council is to be constituted shall be divided into twelve wards as defined in the Second Schedule thereto.
- 5. Upon the election of the Chairman of the Urban Council to be constituted for the town of Moratuwa, the administration of the affairs of that town shall be deemed to be transferred from the Special Commissioner, to the Urban Council and all the property, rights, powers, duties and habilities which are deemed to have been held or performed by or transferred to the Special Commissioner for the purposes of such administration shall be vested in or performed by or transferred to the Urban Council for those purposes

FIRST SCHEDULE

Administrative Limits of the Town of Moratuwa

All that area of land, situated in the villages of Digorella, Egoda Uyana, Idama, Indibedde, Kaldemulla, Katubedda (part), Katukurunda, Koralawella, Laxapathiya, Molpe, Móratumulla, Moratuwella, Rawatawatte, Telawala (part),

Uyana and Willorawatte in Palle Pattuwa of Salpiti Korale, Colombo District, Western Province, and bounded as follows:—

North—By a line drawn from a point on the southern limit of Dehiwala-Mt Lavinia Urban Council area at the centre of north-eastwards, south-Lunawa-ela, eastwards and again north-eastwards along the said limit of the said Urban Council area to the landmark on the northern boundary of the road to Werahera at the south-eastern corner of lot 1 in P Plan A2064; W P, thence south-eastwards along a line parallel to the centre line of Colombo-Galle road till it meets the southern boundary of Telawala road, thence south-westwards along the said boundary of the said road to a point 5 chains north-east of the centre line of Colombo-Galle road at the centre of its junction with Telawala road, thence south-eastwards and southwards along a line parallel to the centre line of Colombo-Galle Road to a point 5 chains north of the centre line of Katubedda Broadway at the meeting point of the said parallel and the said centre line of the said Broadway, thence south-eastwards along a line parallel to the centre line of the said Broadway to the water edge of Bolgoda lake, thence due eastwards to a point on the centre line of the said lake.

East—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards, north-westwards and thence southwards along the centre line of Bolgoda lake including Maduru-duwa to a point where it meets the centre line of Panadura river, thence south-eastwards, southwards and again south-eastwards along the centre line of Panadura river exclusive of Kaduru-duwa to the northern extremity of the western limit of Panadura Urban Council area, thence south-eastwards and south-westwards along the western limit of Panadura Urban Council Area to a point on the centre line of the railway bridge over Panadura River

South.—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point south-westwards along the western limit of Panadura Urban Council area to the centre of confluence of Panadura River and the sea.

West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards to a point on the low water mark of the sea, thence north-westwards along the low water mark of the sea to the centre of confluence of Lunawa-ela and the sea, thence north-eastwards and north-westwards along the centre line of Lunawa-ela to the starting point of the northern limit of the area.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Wards of the Town of Moratuwa

Ward No. 1-Laxapathiya-Kaldemulla

North.—By a lme drawn from the western extremity of the northern limit of the Urban Council area north-eastwards, south-eastwards and again north-eastwards along the said limit to the landmark on the northern boundary of the road to Werahera at the south-eastern corner of lot 1 in P. Plan A 2064, W. P.

East.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards and south-westwards along the northern limit of the Urban Council area to a point on the southern boundary of Telawala Road 5 chains north-east of the centre of the junction of the said road and Colombo-Galle Road, thence northwards to the centre line of Telawala Road, thence south-westwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of its junction with Colombo-Galle Road, thence south-eastwards and south-westwards along the centre line of Colombo-Galle Road till it meets the southern limit of Laxapathiya Village.

West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the centre line of Lunawa Lagoon till it meets the western limit of the Urban Council area, thence north-eastwards and north-westwards along the said limit to the starting point of the northern limit of the

Ward No. 2-Rawatawatte

North.—By a line drawn from the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 1 eastwards, northwards and north-eastwards along the said limit to its eastern extremity, thence southwestwards along the centre line of Colombo-Galle Road till it meets the northern limit of Rawatawatte Village, thence eastwards along the said limit of the said village to its eastern extremity.

East—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards and southwards along the eastern limit of Rawatawatte Village to its southern extremity.

South—By a lme drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the southern limit of Rawatawatte Village till it meets the centre line of Circular Road North, thence westwards along the centre lme of the said road and Church Avenue to the centre of the junction of the said Avenue and Colombo-Galle Road, thence westwards crossing Colombo-Galle Road and along the southern limit of Rawatawatte Village till it meets the centre line of Lunawa Lagoon

West.—By a line drawn from the last mentioned point north-westwards along the centre line of Lunawa Lagoon to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward

.Ward No 3-Katubedda

North—By a line drawn from a point on the eastern limit of Ward No. 1 at the centre of the junction of Colombo-Galle Road and Telawala Road north-eastwards along the said limit of the said ward till it meets the northern limit of the Urban Council area, thence south-eastwards southwards and again south-eastwards along the northern limit of the Urban Council area to its eastern extremity.

- East—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the northern limit of Molpe Village
- South—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point westwards, southwards, south-westwards, eastwards and again southwards along the northern and western limits of Molpe Village till it meets the centre line of De Soysa Road, thence westwards along the centre line of the said road till it meets the eastern limit of Ward No 2
- West—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards and north-westwards along the eastern limit of Ward No 2, westwards and north-eastwards along the northern limit of the said ward and north-eastwards and north-westwards along the eastern limit of Ward No 1 to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 4-Willorawatte

- North—By a line drawn from the southern limit of Ward No 3 at the western extremity of the northern limit of Molpe Village north-eastwards, northwards and eastwards along the said limit of the said ward till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area
- East—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the southern limit of Willorawatte Village
- South—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point north-westwards along the southern limit of Willorawatte Village to its western extremity.
- West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards and northwards along the western limit of Willorawatte Village till it meets the southern limit of Ward No 3 at the centre line of De Soysa Road, thence northwards, westwards and north-eastwards along the said limit to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.
- Note.-Maduru Duwa is included in the ward.

Ward No. 5-Indibedda

- North—By a line drawn from a point where the western limit of Indibedda Village meets the western limit of Ward No 4 south-eastwards along the western and southern limits of the said ward till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area
- East and South—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point south-eastwards, southwestwards and north-westwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the western limit of Indibedda Village
- West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-eastwards along the western limit of Indibedda Village to the centre line of Moratumulla Road South, thence north-westwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of its junction with Moratumulla Road East, thence eastwards along the centre line of Moratumulla Road East, till it meets the western limit of Indibedda Village, thence north-westwards along the said limit to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 6-Moratumulla

- North.—By a line drawn from the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 3 eastwards along the said limit till it meets the western limit of Ward No 4.
- East—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards, south-eastwards and south-westwards along the western limits of Wards Nos. 4 and 5 till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.
- South.—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point westwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the eastern limit of Idama Village
- West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards along the eastern limit of Idama Village till it meets the southern limit of Ward No 2, thence northeastwards and northwards along the southern and eastern limits of the said ward to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No 7-Idama

- North.—By a line drawn from the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 2 eastwards along the said limit till it meets the western limit of Ward No 6.
- East—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards along the western limit of Ward No 6 till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.
- South.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the northern limit of Digorella Village, thence north-westwards along the said limit till it meets the centre line of Mount Road, thence north-westwards and south-westwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of its junction with Colombo-Galle Road.
- West—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards along the centre line of Colombo-Galle Road to the centre of its junction with St Joseph's Street, thence westwards along the centre lime of St. Joseph's Street till it meets the eastern limit of Uyana Village, thence northwards along the said limit to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 8-Uyana

- North—By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area at the centre of the confluence of Lunawa ela and the Sea north-eastwards along the said limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the western limit of Ward No 1.
- East.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards and southwards along the western limits of Wards Nos. 1, 2 and 7 till it meets the centre line of St. Joseph's Street
- South—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point south-westwards along the centre line of St Joseph's Street and Holy Cross Avenue till it meets the eastern boundary of Lady Soysa Drive, thence south-westwards in prolongation of the centre line of Holy Cross Avenue till it meets the western limit of the Urban Council area.

West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 9-Moratumulla

- North.—By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area at the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 8 north-eastwards along the said limit of the said ward and the western limit of Ward No. 7 to a point at the centre of the junction of St. Joseph's Street and Colombo-Galle Road, thence southwards, north-eastwards and southeastwards along the western and southern limits of Ward No. 7 till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.
- East.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards and south-eastwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the northern limit of Koralawella Village.
- South—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point south-westwards along the northern limit of Koralawella Village till it meets the western limit of the Urban Council area.
- West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 10—Koralawella

- North.—By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area at the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No 9 north-eastwards along the said limit of the said ward till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.
- East.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards and southwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets the northern limit of Katukurunda Village.
- South.—By a line drawn from the last mentioned point south-westwards along the northern limit of Katukurunda Village till it meets the western limit of the Urban Council area.
- West—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 11-Katukúrunda

- North—By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area at the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 10 north-eastwards along the said limit of the said ward till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.
- East.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area till it meets a point on a line in prolongation eastwards of the centre line of Goraka-polatotupola Road.
- South.—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point south-westwards along a line in prolongation of the centre line

of Gorakapolatotupola Road and along the centre line of the said road till it meets the eastern boundary of Egoda Uyana Road, thence south-westwards in prolongation of the said centre line till it meets the western limit of the Urban Council

West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 12-Egoda Uyana

- North.—By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area at the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 11 north-eastwards along the said limit till it meets the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.
- East.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards and south-westwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to its southern extremity.
 - South.—By a line drawn from the lastmentioned point south-westwards along the southern limit of the Urban Council area to its western extremity.
 - West.—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.
