MOTOR TRAFFIC ACT, No. 14 OF 1951

List of Applications for Public Carriers' Permits in continuation of existing Public Carriers' Permits for use of Lorries for Fee or Reward

IN terms of section 87 (2) of the Motor Traffic Act, No. 14 of 1951, notice is hereby given of the following applications for Public Carriers' Permits for use of Lorries for Fee or Reward.

The following extract from the Act applies to objections against the grant of such applications :---

"87 (3) any person already providing transport facilities, whether by means of road transport or any other means of transport, for the carriage of goods for fee or reward in the area or any part of the area or between any places which the applicant intends to serve under the authority of the permit applied for, may, on payment of the prescribed fee, make objection against the grant of the application on the ground that suitable transport facilities in that area or part or between those places are or, if the application were granted, would be either generally or in respect of any particular type of lorries, in excess of requirements, or on the ground that any of the conditions of any permit held by the applicant has not been complied with.

An objection may be made under this sub-section on behalf of the Railway by the General Manager of Railways or any other officer of his department authorized by him for the purpose; no fee shall be payable in respect of any such objection."

Objections must be made in the manner stated below to the Commissioner of Motor Traffic, 33, Torrington Place, Colombo, so as to be received by him not later than 10.30 a.m. on Saturday, December 5, 1953.

- 1. Every objection against the grant of any application for a Public Carriers' Permit shall be made by a written statement on suitable paper and shall be signed by the person making the objection. Where the objection is made by any body corporate or a firm, it shall be signed by a person duly authorized in that behalf by such body or a partner of the firm, as the case may be, giving the designation of the person signing it.
- 2. Every statement of objection shall be made in duplicate and the original shall, except where the objection is made by or on behalf of the General Manager of the Railway, bear stamps to the value of Rs. 2 50.
- 3. Every statement of objection shall indicate by reference to the serial number given in the notice and to the name of the applicant, the application in respect of which the objection is made, and shall set out the specific grounds on which the objection is based.
 - 4. No statement of objection shall relate to more than one application.
- 5. Every statement of objection shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope and addressed to the Commissioner of Motor Traffic (Branch L), and delivered at the office of the Commissioner or sent by registered post so as to reach the Commissioner not later than the date specified in the notice.

Any person interested in any application may, on payment of Re. 1, inspect such application at this office during the period of fourteen days after the publication of this notice.

Objectors are requested to state clearly in their objections the facts entitling them to object, i e., whether they are already providing transport facilities, &c., and if so, by what means, and if by lorries, the registered numbers of the lorries. If the objection is in respect of a particular lorry or lorries only being specified in the permit, the numbers of those lorries should be indicated in the statement of objections.

Objections not conforming to these requirements will be of no avail.
