THE AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL CREDIT CORPORATION OF CEYLON

Rules framed under Section 85 (1) (j) of Ordinance No. 19 of 1943

IT is hereby notified that the rules framed by the Board of Directors under section 85 (1) (j) of the Agricultural and Industrial Credit Corporation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1943, and published in *Gazette*, No. 9,920 of November 19, 1943, and as amended from time to time, have been further amended by the Board of Directors and ratified by the Hon. the Minister of Finance as specified in the schedule hereto

SCHEDULE

<i>Provision of Rule</i>	<i>Nature and extent of Amendment</i>
Rule 1	In rule 1 for the words "in the case of a mortgage bond executed on or before the thirtieth day of September 1953" there shall be substituted the words "In the case of a mortgage bond which stipulates repayment of the loan by equal half-yearly instalments of principal together with interest computed on the reducing balances"
Rule 2	In rule 2 for the words "In the case of a mortgage bond executed on and after the first day of October 1953" there shall be substituted the words "In the case of a mortgage bond which stipulates repayment of the loan by way of equated payments"
Rule 2 (a)	In rule 2 (a) for the words "is paid within the period of thirty days next following the due date, he shall pay additional interest at the rate of three per centum on the amount of such instalment, and "there shall be substituted the words "is paid within the period of one month immediately following the due date he shall pay additional interest calculated at the rate of three per centum per annum from the due date up to the date of payment on the balance principal outstanding on the due date, and"
Rule 2 (b)	In rule 2 (b) for the words "is paid after the period of thirty days next following the due date, he shall pay additional interest at the rate of three per centum on the balance principal outstanding on the due date" there shall be substituted the words "is in arrear for over the period of one month immediately following the due date he shall pay additional interest calculated at the rate of three per centum per annum on the balance principal outstanding on the due date for the period commencing from the day immediately following the due date of the last preceding instalment and ending with the due date of such instalment in arrear both days inclusive"
Rule 3	The rule shall be repealed and the following new rule substituted therefor — "3 Where a borrower under any mortgage bond which stipulates repayment of the loan by equal half-yearly instalments of principal together with interest computed on the reducing balances is permitted by the Board at any time to repay the principal then outstanding by way of equated payments and such borrower makes default in the payment of any instalment, he shall be liable to pay additional interest as provided in rule 2"
