GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay), appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

Qualifications required.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A “Ceylonese” is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service (commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest), from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

APPLICATIONS are invited for the post of Probationary Assistant Agricultural Engineer (Temporary) in the Department of Agriculture. Applications, which should be on a special form obtainable from this office, should reach me on or before the following dates:—

- (a) Local applications April 9, 1954.
(b) Overseas applications April 23, 1954.

2. *Salary, Allowances and Conditions of Service.*—(i) The salary scale attached to the post is as follows:—

On trial Rs. 3,000—3 of 360—Rs. 4,080 per annum.
On appointment as Assistant Agricultural Engineer (temporary) Rs. 4,800—10 of 360 and 9 of 480—Rs. 12,720 per annum with efficiency bars before Rs. 8,040 and Rs. 11,280 and a 2-year halt on Rs. 10,800.

To proceed beyond Rs. 7,680 full professional qualifications, i.e., an Associate Membership of a professional institute, is required.

(ii) The selected candidate will be required to undergo training for a period of 4 years on the salary scale Rs. 3,000—360—Rs. 4,080 per annum. If his services are continued, after undergoing successful training and obtaining such further qualifications as may be determined by the Department, he will be appointed to the post of Assistant Agricultural Engineer (temporary) and placed on Rs. 4,800 per annum in the scale Rs. 4,800 to Rs. 12,720 per annum referred to above. Before he can proceed beyond a salary of Rs. 7,680 per annum he will be required to obtain full professional qualifications (i.e., he should be elected an Associate Member of a professional institute). A candidate trained abroad at Government expense will be required to enter into an agreement to serve Government for a specified period of years.

POSTS OF MEDICAL OFFICERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

APPLICATIONS are invited from Medical practitioners (both sexes) registered under the Medical Ordinance for service as Medical Officers in the Department of Health. Appointments will be made either into the Curative or Health sides of the Department. Applications will close on March 26, 1954. Candidates who have sat for the M.B.B.S. (Ceylon) examination in March, 1954, may apply pending results.

2. Reference is invited to the general conditions applicable to appointments to posts in the Public Service published at the beginning of Part I, Section II, of this Gazette.

3. *Salary, Allowance and Conditions of Service.*—The salary scale for the Preliminary Grade is Rs. 4,800—5,520 per annum with annual increments of Rs. 360. After three years in the Preliminary Grade, officers will enter Grade II of the Curative or the Health sides to which they have been appointed provided they pass the Departmental examination within the stipulated time. In the case of officers who fail to pass the Departmental examination within the prescribed period, their increments and promotion to Grade II will be deferred by the period of time taken in excess of the period prescribed for passing the examination. The salary scales are as follows:—

Curative side: Grade II, Rs. 5,880—360—8,400 per annum; Grade I, Rs. 8,880—480—10,800 per annum. Two years on Rs. 8,400 per annum.

Grade I and Grade II are on a continuous time scale.

Health side: Grade II, Rs. 6,240—360 & 480—10,800 per annum. Two years on Rs. 10,800. Grade I, Rs. 11,280—480—12,720 per annum.

Grade I and Grade II are on a continuous time scale.

(i) Payment of salary on the Grade I scale will depend on the acquisition of additional professional qualifications prescribed by the department from time to time.

4. *Terms of Engagement.*—The posts are temporary and officers will be considered for permanent appointments as and when vacancies occur in the permanent cadre of Medical Officers and Medical Officers of Health. The appointment of female medical officers will be non-pensionable and the selected candidates in this category will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salaries to the Public Service Provident Fund and will be allowed to contribute at their option a further 5 per cent. The government contribution in either case will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(i) The appointments will be on two years' trial. The selected candidates will be required to pass the Departmental examination as per notification of November 11, 1948, appearing in the *Government Gazette* of November 19, 1948, within two years of the date of appointment.

(ii) The selected candidates should be prepared to serve both on the Curative and Health sides of the Department, as well as in posts of the Quarantine Department, including those in South India, and in the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ceylon.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—(i) The post is permanent but non-pensionable. The appointment will in the first instance be on trial for a period of two years.

- (b) is a Graduate of a recognized University or has at least passed the First Examination in Arts or Science of the University of Ceylon or the Intermediate Examination or equivalent examination of any other recognized University;
- (c) has a first class knowledge of the English language and a general knowledge of Western literature and music;
- (d) is of good character and physically sound

(ii) Applications will also be considered from candidates not possessing the above educational qualifications but who have had previous experience in broadcasting work either in Ceylon or elsewhere. These candidates when applying must furnish proof of such experience.

(iii) The successful candidates will be required to write scripts for all types of broadcasts, including feature programmes and may be required to adapt books, features, and stage plays for broadcasting. Experience of writing for the radio will be a considerable asset, though other fields of authorship, such as journalism may offer a satisfactory substitute. Experience of teaching will be an added qualification.

5. Applicants must attach to their applications COPIES (NOT ORIGINALS) of—

- (i) certificate of registration of birth (Baptismal certificates or certificates issued for the purpose of the Education Code will not be accepted);
- (ii) certificate of the highest academic qualifications obtained; and

18. The Contractor shall, whenever required to do so by the Commissioner of Labour, supply him with full particulars of the categories of workers employed by the Contractor under the contract for this work.

19. The Contractor shall indemnify the Government against any claim by or in respect of any employee of the Contract under the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1934, or any statutory modification hereof.
