Notice under Section 35



## Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946

#### Section 39 (5)

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 39 (5) of the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946, I, Godfrey Prasad Tambayah, Commissioner of Parliamentary Elections, hereby order that no male polling agent shall be admitted, during the hours of polling, to the polling stations which are specified in the Schedule hereto, and which are reserved exclusively for the use of female voters
