THE CEYLON (PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946

Notice under Section 35

Election of a member of the House of Representatives for the Electoral District No. 80, Buttala, in pursuance of a Notice under Section 24 (2) of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, and Section 27 of the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946, published in Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 10,747 of December 27, 1954

NOTICE is hereby given under section 35 (3) of the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946, that—

- (1) the election of a member of the House of Representatives in the Electoral District No. 80, Buttala, is contested, and that a poll will be taken in the said electoral district on the fifth day of March, 1955, between eight o'clock in the forenoon and five o'clock in the afternoon,
- (2) the names of candidates, in the order in which they will be printed on the ballot papers, the symbol allotted to each candidate, the name of the proposer and seconder of each candidate, the situation of the polling station or polling stations for each of the polling districts in that electoral district, and the particular polling stations reserved for female voters are as specified in the Schedule hereto
