ORDER made by the Minister of Commerce, Trade and Fisheries under regulation 4 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, which has the force of law by virtue of the Import and Export Control (Continuation) Act, No. 27 of 1950.

The Order made under regulation 4 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations and published at page 2 of the Supplement to Gazette No. 8,855 of Jamuary 30, 1942 (as amended by an subsequent Order), is hereby further amended, in the Cabodula there are follows: in the Schedule thereto, as follows:

- (1) by the substitution, for item, 102, of the following new item:—
 - Artificial silk manufactures—other than apparel handkerchiefs, mufflers, scarves and banian cloth ... III ... M"; " 102—Artificial
- (2) by the insertion, immediately after item 102A, of the following new item:——

 "102A—Artificial silk manufactures:

 Banian cloth . . . III . . . M";
- (3) by the substitution, for item 104, of the following new item:-
 - "104—All apparel of artificial silk, wool, cotton, leather or any other material other than silk or satin (including hosiery, haberdashery, hats, millinery and artificial flowers, but excluding boots, shoes, leather belts, cotton shirts, cotton banians and artificial silk banians)
 ... III ... M"; and

- (4) by the insertion, immediately after item 104A, of the following new items:-
 - "104B—Cotton shirts ... III ... M 104c—Cotton banians . . . III . . . M
 - 104D—Artificial silk banians III . . . M ".

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regula-tion 5A, of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, which has the force of law by virtue negulations, which has the force of law by virtue of the Import and Export Control (Continuation) Act, No. 27 of 1950, Il Charles Edwin Perera Jayasuriya, Controller of Imports, do hereby amend the Schedule to Open General Licence No. 4, dated September 23, 1952, and published in Gazette Extraordinary, No. 10,452. September 24, 1952 (as amended by any seequent Notification), as follows:—

- (1) by the substitution, for item 24, of the following new item.
 - "24-Artificial silk manufactures, other than apparel, handkerchiefs, muff-lers, scarves and banian cloth ... III ... M", and
- (2) by the substitution, for item 30, of the following new item :-
 - "30-All apparel of artificial silk, wool, cotton, leather or any material other than silk or satin (including hosiery, haberdashery, hats, millinery and artificial flowers, but excluding boots, shoes, leather belts, cotton shirts, cotton banians and artificial silk banians . . . III . . .

IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 5/55

Importation of Cotton Shirts, Banians and Banian Cloth

THE attention of Importers is drawn to the amendment to Regulation 4 of the Perence (Control of Imports) Regulations; and to the amendment to Open General Literica No. 10 dated March 3, 1955, and published if Gazette Engaordinary No. 19772 of March 6, 1955

- 2. Attence is now required for the important of the following items from any source:
 - (1) Artificial ilk barian cloth .. C 102AA,
 - (2) Cotton slights
 - (3) Cotton banisms ... C 104C, and

#04B.

(4) - Artificial, silk bassans ... C 104D.

- 3. Importers are requested to forward to this office on or before March 21, 1955, statements of their confirmed outstanding orders which cannot be cancelled supported by documentary evidence. A separate statement should be forwarded in respect of each item and for each country giving the Car. value in rupees for each outstanding order.
- 4. No further orders should be placed for any of these goods on any source unless an import licence has been obtained.
- 5. The attention of importers is also drawn to para 2 of Import Control Notice No. 24/53 of September 30, 1953, regarding cotton banian cloth—C 96B. A licence is also required to import cotton banian cloth from any source.
