Date of Examination—A competitive examination for candidates wishing to enter Grade II of the Local Government Electrical Foremen's Service will be held in Colombo on February 27, 1954. The examination will be conducted by the Local Government Service Commission.

2 (i) *Salary*—Successful candidates will be appointed as vacancies occur to posts in Grade II of the Local Government Electrical Foremen's Service to serve local authorities (other than Village Committees) on the salary scale Rs 744 per annum, rising by 16 annual increments of Rs 42 to Rs 1,416 per annum, with an efficiency bar before Rs 1,080 per annum. Rent allowance in accordance with Government rates and conditions, a temporary cost of living allowance and a special living allowance at Government rates, will be paid.

(ii) *Conditions of Service*—(a) The grant of leave and other conditions will be governed by the by-laws and regulations of the local authority subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No 43 of 1945, and any regulations framed thereunder

(c) Successful candidates with previous continuous service in a local authority drawing a salary higher than the initial salary assigned to the post of Foremen, Grade II, may be placed on a suitable step on this salary scale

3. The names of successful candidates will be published in Part IV of the *Ceylon Government Gazette*, and they will be given appointments as suitable vacancies occur

4 *Eligibility*—(i) Candidates must be of good character

(ii) Candidates must be Ceylonese

(iii) (a) Candidates should have previously passed at least the 7th Standard or higher examination in English

(b) They should have had at least five years of practical experience in an electrical engineering firm or under a chartered electrical engineer or under Government or local supply authority, or should possess technical qualifications of the Ceylon Technical College or its equivalent; and

(c) should have a knowledge of the operation and maintenance of high tension and low tension distribution system, transformers, diesel engine plant and switchgear, testing of consumers' installations, and house service metres. Should also possess a working knowledge of the safety rules and IEE Regulations for electrical equipment and buildings

Note—Applications from persons holding permanent posts in a town lighting scheme of a local authority having the necessary technical knowledge and experience will be considered, irrespective of general educational qualifications, if forwarded through the Chairman, Municipal Commissioner, or Special Commissioner of the local authority.

(v) The Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, will issue admission forms to those candidates whose applications are accepted. Candidates presenting themselves for examination must produce to the officer appointed to supervise the examination their forms of admission. A candidate not producing such form will be refused admittance to the examination.

Candidates must sit for the examination at the examination hall assigned to them. A candidate presenting himself at an examination hall other than the one assigned to him will be refused admission to the examination.

A copy of the time table and the rules for the guidance of candidates for the examination will be forwarded together with the admission form. These should be read carefully by candidates. Every candidate presenting himself for the examination must give up his admission form to the Supervising Examiner on the day of the examination.

If a candidate does not receive his admission form at least seven days before the day of the examination, he should communicate without delay with the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, informing that he has not received the admission form and giving the following particulars:—

- (ii) Local Government Law. (This paper will be based on the Municipal, Urban and Town Councils Ordinances, regulations and by-laws framed thereunder and the Local Government Service Ordinances, amending legislation, and regulations framed thereunder.)

II. The examination in Sinhalese and Tamil will be divided into—

- (a) Conversation and interpretation
(b) Reading and writing

III. Officers of Sinhalese, Tamil and Moor parents will be required to pass in one language and accounts, and Local Government Law.

IV. Officers of other parentage will be required to pass accounts and Local Government law, and one language (Conversation and interpretation only.)

V. In the examination under Rule II (a) above, the candidate will be tested in conversation so as to satisfy the examiner as to his power of understanding Sinhalese or Tamils of different classes and of making himself understood by them both in common conversation and in the course of official business. He will also be required to act as interpreter between the examiners and Sinhalese and Tamils entirely ignorant of English, the interpretation to be on matters connected with ordinary official business. The candidate will be required in this examination to obtain a minimum of 50 per cent of the total marks.

VI. In the examination under Rule II (b) above, the candidate will be required to write an English translation of two short Sinhalese or Tamil reports written in different running hands, to translate a short extract from a Sinhalese or Tamil notarial deed and from the proceedings of a rural court case put into his hands for the first time. The candidates will be required in this examination to obtain a minimum of 50 per cent of the total marks.

VII. Candidates for the examination under Rule I (b) above will be required to obtain a minimum of 50 per cent of the total marks in accounts and Local Government Law.

EXEMPTION FROM THE NATIONAL LANGUAGES PAPER

ALL OFFICERS WHO WERE TRANSFERRED TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE ON APRIL 1, 1946, ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE NATIONAL LANGUAGES PAPERS OF THIS EXAMINATION.
