THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

Customs Notification (General)

IT is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 19 of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 185), as modified by the Proclamations published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, and in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,828 of February 5, 1948, the Minister of Finance has directed that, with effect from May 2, 1954—

- (1) all duties of Customs, as well as penalties and forfeitures incurred under that Ordinance, shall be paid and received at the rates of exchange set out in the Schedule hereto ; and
- (2) the notification relating to the rates of exchange published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,653 of March 12, 1954, is hereby cancelled.
