THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE

Notification

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the Supplement to *Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Edward Alexander Nugawela, Minister of Health, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent, Eastern Province, the proper authority in that behalf on May 3, 1954.

SCHEDULE

The villages of Tirukovil and Thambiluvil Divisions 1 and 2 in the D. R. O's Division of Akkaraipattu, bounded as follows :—

North—by Periya Kalapuwa and Periyamuhathuwaram causeway on the main Akkaraipattu-Pottuvil road near the 43rd Mile Post ;

East—by the sea ;

South—by the Sagamam road up to Kanchurankudah junction and Korai Kalapuwa Lagoon ; and

West—by Periya Kalapuwa Lagoon and Paddy fields.
