THE COURTS ORDINANCE

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 26 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 8), as modified by the Proclamation under Section 88 (1) of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Alan Edward Percival Rose, Chief Justice, do, after consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, hereby order that, in addition to the Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court for the Southern Circuit which commences at Galle on the Twenty-sixth day of April, 1954, a Sessions of that Court for that Circuit shall be holden at Matara, commencing at such place on the Twenty-sixth day of April, 1954
