 - (b) by the omission of sub-paragraph (iv) of that proviso;
- (2) in regulation 5, by the substitution in paragraph (2) thereof, for the words “end of that period.”, of the following:—

“end of that period. In the case of Exchanges fitted with “chargeable time clocks”, the clock will give these announcements automatically 12 seconds before the end of each period of three minutes in order to allow the caller to end the call, if he so desires.”;
- (3) by the substitution, for regulation 6, of the following new regulation:—

“6 A call shall be regarded as effective and the full fee for such call shall be charged—

 - (a) if there is no reply from a subscriber to a licensed private exchange; or
 - (b) if the line of a subscriber to a licensed private exchange is out of order, or is reported when the call is passed to the private exchange, to be temporarily out of service or not connected at that time.”;
- (4) in regulation 7, by the substitution in paragraph (f), for the words “Government exchange subscriber”, of the words “Government manual exchange subscriber”;
- (5) by the substitution, for regulation 8, of the following new regulation:—

“8. (1) No fee shall be charged when a call is cancelled before the attention of the called subscriber is obtained.

(2) The appropriate trunk fee for a unit period of three minutes shall be charged if a call is cancelled or refused after the called number is placed in communication with the calling number.”;
- (6) in regulation 9, by the substitution, in paragraph (4), for the words and figures “in rule 8 (1) and (2)”, of the words and figures “in rule 8 (1)”; and

ACCOUNTANCY BOARD, CEYLON

Companies (Auditors) Regulations, 1941

RULES PRESCRIBED BY THE ACCOUNTANCY BOARD PURSUANT TO
REGULATIONS 6 AND 6A OF THE COMPANIES (AUDITORS)
REGULATIONS, 1941

THESE rules shall apply to Articles of Apprenticeship and Examinations of the Board to be held in and after December, 1956.

(Note.—The existing rules governing Articles of Apprenticeship and Examinations will continue to remain in force and will be applicable to the conduct of examinations up to and inclusive of the June, 1956, Examinations.)

1. Except as otherwise expressly provided in the Companies (Auditors) Regulations, 1941, persons wishing to qualify themselves for enrolment on the Register shall be required to pass the Intermediate and Final Examinations, and to complete the practical training as prescribed in these rules.

2. Articles shall be served under a Registered Auditor approved by the Board, in practice in Ceylon as an Accountant and Auditor.

3. No person shall be eligible to enter into articles unless such person—

(a) is not less than 17 years of age on the date of commencement of articles; and

(b) has passed the Ceylon Higher School Certificate Examination or holds an equivalent qualification.

The period of articles shall be—

(i) in the case of a graduate — 3 years;

(ii) in any other case — 5 years.

A clerk who enters into articles of agreement as a non-graduate will be given the concession of a reduction in the period of his articles on his obtaining a university degree provided he shows to the satisfaction of the Board that the time taken in obtaining the degree plus the period of service under articles is not less than five years.

4. The articles (in triplicate) shall be executed in form A of the first schedule. The Principals shall inform the Secretary, Accountancy Board, of the execution of the articles within 7 days thereof. The articles together with the necessary documentary evidence showing that the conditions laid down in clauses (a) and (b) of rule 3 are satisfied, shall be sent to the Secretary for registration within 28 days after the execution of the articles and shall be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 2 and by a statement giving particulars of the name, father's name, residence and the age of the articulated clerk.

Any service before the date of execution of the deed shall not form part of the period of service under articles.

5. Any period served under articles recognised for the purpose of their examinations by the Institutes or Societies of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales, Scotland or Ireland or the Society of Incorporated Accountants and Auditors, London, or of the Society of Ceylon Accountants and Auditors, provided that the articles were entered into before August 1, 1950, will be set off against the practical training prescribed under rules 1 to 4 above at the discretion of the Board.

6. The register of Articled Clerks shall be maintained by the Secretary to the Accountancy Board.

7. A person who has been/is the holder of a temporary certificate or a restricted certificate shall not be required to pass the Intermediate Examination.

8. No candidate shall be admitted to the Intermediate Examination unless he has completed half the prescribed period of articles and produces a certificate to that effect from his principal in form B annexed to the application form so long as he is under articles, and subsequently on lodging with the Secretary a discharge certificate from his principal as to his satisfactory completion of his full period of articles.

9. Every candidate for admission to the Intermediate Examination shall pay the Registrar of Companies a fee of Rs. 50. A candidate who elects to sit for the examination in two parts shall pay a fee of Rs. 35 for each part. The fee payable for a referred subject shall be Rs. 25.

10. (a) The Intermediate Examination will be divided into two parts, namely Part I and Part II and every candidate is required to pass in both parts. A candidate may elect to take the examination in two parts or, alternatively, he may take the whole examination at one sitting.

(b) A candidate who elects to sit for the whole examination at one sitting must pass in both parts if he is to be regarded as having passed the whole examination. In the event of a candidate failing in one part only, he may be re-examined in that part at a subsequent examination.

(c) The system of referring a candidate in any one subject shall apply only where the candidate takes the whole examination at one sitting. He may be referred in paper No. 4, "General Commercial Knowledge" only.

(d) A candidate so referred should pass this paper at the examination immediately following the examination at which he was referred. If he fails at this second attempt, he will be required to sit for both papers in Part II subsequently.

 - (iii) No candidate will be referred in " Mercantile Law and Company Law " under the old syllabus at the June, 1956, examination.
11. No candidate shall be admitted to the Final Examination unless he—
- (i) has either passed the Intermediate Examination or is exempted from passing that examination ; and
 - (ii) has either completed the period of service under articles prescribed by Rule 3 or is serving the last 3 months of the said period or is exempted from service under articles.

Provided that in the case of every candidate an interval of not less than eleven months shall have elapsed between the date of his completing the Intermediate Examination and the commencement of the Final Examination.

Such candidate should have either lodged with the Secretary a discharge certificate from his principal as to his satisfactory completion of the full period of articles or should have furnished on a previous occasion form E Certificate annexed to the application form duly signed by his principal.

12. Every candidate for admission to the Final Examination shall pay the Registrar of Companies a fee of Rs. 75. A candidate who elects to sit for the examination in two parts shall pay a fee of Rs. 50 for each part. The fee payable for a referred subject shall be Rs. 37.50.

13. (a) The Final Examination will be divided into two parts, namely, Part I and Part II and every candidate is required to pass in both parts. A candidate may elect to take the examination in two parts or, alternatively, he may take the whole examination at one sitting.

(b) A candidate who elects to sit for the whole examination at one sitting must pass in both parts if he is to be regarded as having passed the whole examination. In the event of a candidate failing in one part only he may be re-examined in that part at a subsequent examination.

(c) The system of referring a candidate in any one subject shall apply only where the candidate takes the whole examination at one sitting. He may be referred in any subject in Part II only.

(d) A candidate so referred should pass in that paper at the examination immediately following the examination at which he was referred. If he fails at this second attempt, he will be required to sit for all papers in Part II subsequently.

14 The examinations shall be conducted in such manner as the Accountancy Board may direct.

15. (a) Applications for admission to an examination shall be made on the prescribed form which may be obtained from the Secretary to the Accountancy Board. Every such application together with the prescribed fee shall be sent so as to reach the Secretary, Accountancy Board, 30 days before the date fixed for the commencement of the examination.

(b) The first application for admission to an examination from a candidate applying under Rule 5, other than from clerks who have served articles for the Society of Ceylon Accountants and Auditors, should be received by the Secretary, at least 3 months before the date fixed for the commencement of the examination.

16. The fee paid by a candidate who has been admitted to an examination shall not in any circumstances be refunded. If such a candidate is subsequently prevented from attending the examination to which he was admitted the Accountancy Board may, if it is satisfied that he was prevented from attending by circumstances beyond his control, permit the fee to be transferred to the next examination.

17. A notice stating the place, dates and times at which the candidate will be required to present himself for examination shall be sent to each candidate to the address given by him in his application so as to reach him not less than fourteen days before the commencement of the examination.

18. Every candidate completing the Intermediate and/or Final Examination shall be furnished with a certificate to that effect.

19. If a candidate is found to have resorted to unfair means during the conduct of an examination or to have attempted to influence an examiner, the Accountancy Board, may, on receipt of a report to that effect from any examiner or any person duly authorized to conduct the examination, remove the name of such candidate from the list of those entered for the examination and may direct that a candidate whose name has been so removed shall not be admitted to the next or to any subsequent examination held under these rules.
