TSUNAMI AFFECTED LIBRARIES

A large number of libraries have been affected by the Indian Ocean Tsunami occured on 26th December 2004. According to available information 70 public libraries, 11 temple libraries and 08 special/Institution libraries have been destroyed or damaged by the Tsunami. In addition, 182 schools have been damaged. Most of these schools had libraries too. The NLDSB has launched a special programme in association with UNESCO, SLLA and other organisations to assist the tsunami affected libraries. 13th CONFERENCE OF DIRECTORS OF NATIONAL LIBRARIES IN ASIA AND OCEANIA (CDNLAO)


