GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

Qualifications required.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER THE UNITED NATIONS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION—TRAINING IN SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES

APPLICATIONS are invited from officers serving in the Ministry of Industries, Housing and Social Services, the departments under that Ministry and the Department of Cottage Industries for the award of 2 Fellowships under the auspices of the United Nations Technical Assistance Administration for training in Small Scale Industries. Applications which should be on a special form obtainable from this office and in the applicants own handwriting should reach me on or before March 18, 1955.

2. *Terms of Award and Course of Study.*—(1) The selected Fellows will be required to follow an International Course on Small Scale Industries in the Netherlands during the period September, 1955, to March, 1956.

(ii) The course is organized by the Technological University of Delft based on the experience of several years of research in the field of Small Scale Industries undertaken by that University. It includes—

- (a) A 10-weeks course of theoretical figures and studies in general principles, management, commercial, financial and social aspects of Small Scale Industry, and on technical matters such as the establishment of new Small Scale Industries, organization problems, &c.;
- (b) A 12-weeks period of experimental work in Industry;
- (c) A final session;
- (d) A series of excursions in Small Scale Industries in actual working.

(iii) The cost of passages to and from the Netherlands will be provided by the United Nations Technical Assistance Administration who will also provide admission and tuition fees as well as an adequate living allowance during the period of training.

3. *Qualifications required.*—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he—

- (a) holds a first or second class degree (or equivalent) in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Engineering or Economics of a recognized University;
- (b) is of excellent moral character and physically sound;

Note.—Preference will be given to those candidates who have experience of planning, administration of Industries and management, and those whose subsequent duties are likely to be in these fields.

4. *Agreement and Security.*—The selected candidates will have to—

- (a) enter into agreements with the Government of Ceylon undertaking among other things to follow the prescribed courses and to complete satisfactorily their courses of training and to serve the Ceylon Government, if so required, for a reasonable period (to be decided by Government) after completion of their courses of training;
- (b) enter into bonds undertaking to return the full amount advanced by the Government of Ceylon and/or the Awarding Agency in the event of their failure to comply with the terms and conditions in the agreements.

5 Applications which are received in this office after the prescribed date will not be entertained

unless the Head of the Department concerned recommends acceptance adducing valid reasons for the delay.

6. The selected candidates will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to undergo the course of training and to serve in any part of the Island. The fee for this examination will be payable by the candidates.

7. Applications or any other communications relating thereto must be addressed to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, and not personally to any officer in this Department.

8. Reference is invited to the general conditions applicable to appointments to posts in the Public Service published at the beginning of Part I, Section II, of this *Gazette*. The general conditions specified under the heading "Qualifications Required" and other requirements will apply in the case of this award.

9. All applications will be acknowledged and any applicant who does not receive an acknowledgment within three days of the closing date should at once notify the Secretary, Public Service Commission. Failure to comply with this provision will deprive the applicant of any claim to consideration.

10. It should be clearly understood that the proposed training will not entitle the selected candidates to any enhanced emoluments nor will the selection of candidates under this advertisement bind the Government to its terms which may be varied if necessary.

EXAMINATION FOR TYPISTS

THE notification relating to the above examination published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 10,751 of January 6, 1955, is hereby amended as indicated below.

- (i) Delete sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph 5 and substitute therefor the following sub-paragraph:—

“(iv) Candidates must not be less than 17 years nor more than 26 years of age on March 1, 1955”.

- (ii) Delete sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph 6 and substitute therefor the following sub-paragraph —

“(i) Clerks in the Higher and Lower Grades of the Quasi-Clerical Service.— Clerks in the Higher and Lower Grades of the Quasi-Clerical Service in categories (a), (b) and (c) below will be permitted to sit for this examination:—

- (a) Those in service on January 3, 1955, provided they possess the educational qualifications prescribed in paragraph 5 (iii);

- (b) Those in service on January 3, 1955, (who do not possess the educational qualifications prescribed in paragraph 5 (iii)) provided they are not more than 45 years of age on March 1, 1955, and have passed at least the Cambridge Junior, the Junior School Certificate (English) Examination of the Education Department, Ceylon, the Junior School Certificate (English) Examination held by a school approved by the Education Department, an Examination held by a school approved by the Education Department and certified by the Principal/Head Master as equivalent to the Junior School Certificate (English) Examination of the Education Department, or the Commercial Certificate Examination, either Certificate or Higher Stage, either section of the London Chamber of Commerce, or Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Examination.

- (c) Those who have been confirmed in their appointments on or before January 27, 1955, and are not more than 45 years of age on March 1, 1955.”

- (iii) Add the following new sub-paragraphs at the end of sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph 6:—

“(iv) Persons holding permanent posts in Government employ on January 3, 1955, will be permitted to sit for this examination provided—

- (a) they possess the educational qualifications specified in paragraph 5 (iii);
- (b) they are under 45 years of age on March 1, 1955; and
- (c) their services are certified as satisfactory by the Heads of their Departments and the Heads of

Departments are prepared to release them if they are selected for appointment to the Typists' Service.

Note.—(a) Officers belonging to Departmental Clerical Services such as the Railway, Postal, Survey and Customs Clerical Services, will not be eligible to sit for the examination under the above paragraph. Officers in Departmental Clerical Services, recruitment to which has now ceased, will, however, be eligible.

(b) Successful candidates will not, under any circumstances, be allowed incremental credit for their previous services, and will be appointed to the Typists' Service on the initial salary of the scale for that Service.

(v) Officers holding temporary posts in Government employ on January 3, 1955, who are not eligible for the concessions set out in paragraph 6(i), will be permitted to sit for this examination provided they possess the educational qualifications specified in paragraph 5 (iii) and are under 45 years of age on March 1, 1955”

- (iv) Delete paragraph 12 and substitute therefor the following paragraph:—

“12. *Scheme of Examination.*—The examination will be held in two parts, viz., Part I (Written), Part II (Viva Voce). The subjects of the examination and the marks assigned to each subject are given below. In all written papers marks will be deducted for bad writing and mistakes in spelling. Candidates whose writing is illegible are liable to be disqualified.

Note.—Candidates who take the examination in the English medium should take subjects (1), (2) and

(3) in the English medium and also Subject (4) Sinhalese or Tamil. These candidates must obtain a minimum of 30 per cent. in Subject (4)

C. OPTIONAL SUBJECTS :

(5) *English*—45 minutes .. 50

Note.—Candidates who take the examination in the Sinhalese or Tamil medium may or may not take this subject as their order of merit will not be influenced by the marks scored in it. But those who do not take it or who take it but obtain less than 30 per cent. of the marks in it and are selected for appointment to the Typists' Service will be required to pass a test in English before they are confirmed in their appointments at the end of two years from the dates of their appointments.

Candidates who take the examination in the English medium are not required to take this subject.

(6) *Shorthand* (English or Sinhalese or Tamil). 70 words per minute in English Shorthand, 50 words per minute in Sinhalese or Tamil. Shorthand .. 50

Note.—(a) Candidates may or may not take this subject as their order of merit will not be influenced by the marks scored in it. Candidates who know Shorthand are, however, advised to take the subject.

(b) This subject should be taken in the same medium as subjects (1), (2) and (3) in A above.

Part II (Viva Voce) .. 50

The viva voce examination will be conducted in the medium selected by the candidate in respect of subjects (1), (2) and (3) in Part I A above.

The written examination will be held first and, on the results of it, candidates will be selected competitively to attend the viva voce examination which will be held in Colombo on a date to be notified to them. The number to be called for the viva voce examination will be fixed by the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury in consultation with the Commissioner of Examinations. Candidates, if summoned for the viva voce examination, will be required to produce the originals of their birth and educational certificates and their identity cards. The viva voce examination may, however, be dispensed with in the event of the number of candidates qualifying for it falling short of the number of vacancies."

2. The examination will be held in Colombo by the Commissioner of Examinations commencing on July 2, 1955, and not on March 26, 1955, as previously notified. Application forms should be obtained by personal callers from the Enquiry Office, Department of Examinations, or by post from the Commissioner of Examinations, Malay Street, Slave Island, Colombo 2, from March 11 to 29, 1955. Candidates should specify the medium selected (i.e., whether English, Sinhalese or Tamil) when they apply for forms. Applications

for admission to the examination will be entertained by the Commissioner of Examinations up to March 30, 1955.

3. Candidates who have already forwarded applications in accordance with the notification published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* of January 6, 1955, need not apply again.
