GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay), appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

Qualifications required.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A “Ceylonese” is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service (commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest), from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

(v) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this advertisement will be rejected.

- (b) is a graduate of a recognized University and possesses suitable teaching experience. He must also possess administrative ability and a sound knowledge of educational principles and methods. A good knowledge of Sinhalese or Tamil is essential.
- (c) is of good moral character and physically sound.

5. Applications forwarded through Heads of Departments and received in this office after the prescribed date will not be entertained unless the applications were received by the Head of Department before the prescribed date and the Head of Department concerned recommends acceptance, adducing valid reasons for the delay.

POST OF PRESIDENT, RURAL COURT

THE Judicial Service Commission invites applications from Ceylonese lawyers, possessing a good knowledge of the Tamil language, for a post of President, Rural Court. The post is in the Tamil-speaking area.

**SELECTION OF MEDICAL OFFICERS FOR STUDY
LEAVE 1954/55 ACADEMIC SESSIONS**

IT has been decided to call for applications for study leave abroad. The Policy, terms and conditions, &c., under which study leave will be granted are as stated below

Policy—In view of the fact that it is not necessary hereafter for a Grade II Medical Officer to proceed abroad to obtain qualifications which entitle him to promotion to Grade I, study leave abroad will be granted only to officers who are required to go by the Department to obtain specialist qualifications. The specialties required by the Department will be indicated and officers will have to apply according to specialties. Selection will be made from among applicants for the particular specialties. Seniority alone will not be a claim for selection. The qualifications and the amount of leave will be prescribed by the Department. Applicants should note that once study leave is granted for any speciality they will not be allowed to alter it or practise in any other speciality after their return from study leave.

Terms of Study Leave.—Officers will be granted the under-mentioned assistance by the Department.—

- (1) Full pay (exclusive of rent allowance) during the prescribed period
- (2) A passage to and from England at Government expense
- (3) Reimbursement of all fees (except private tuition fees) of approved courses of study, training and examinations
- (4) Family allowance of Rs. 1,500 per annum during period the officer is compelled to be away from the Island

Conditions under which Study Leave is granted—Officers will have to enter into a bond embodying *inter alia* the following conditions —

- (1) To obtain the prescribed specialist qualifications.
- (2) To serve for ten years after return to Ceylon. Dismissal, &c., to be construed as a failure to continue in service
- (3) To refrain from engaging in private practice except on the following terms.—
 - (a) That private practice shall be limited to a consultation practice
 - (b) That such consultation practice shall be limited to consultation at patient's homes arranged through the medium of other doctors;
 - (c) That the fees for all such consultations shall be fixed by Government and that half thereof shall be paid to the Government of Ceylon
- (4) To agree not to demand or receive fees from any member of the public for professional services rendered to any Government Medical Institution.

Failure to fulfil or observe the above-mentioned conditions of the bond will make an officer liable to payment of a penalty not exceeding Rs. 20,000 according to the following table —

It will be the endeavour of the Department to find accommodation and places at the various centres of training and selected officers are expected to inform me of their requirements so that arrangements may be made through the High Commissioner for Ceylon in the United Kingdom.

Officers are requested to send in their applications **UNDER REGISTERED COVER** to reach this Office not later than April 21, 1954, mentioning reasons, if any, for special consideration. The applications should, as far as possible, be self-explanatory and should not contain references to, or be in continuation of, previous applications which are treated as cancelled. Officers should note that the qualifications mentioned in the schedule are alternative qualifications and as the Department will be prescribing the qualifications to meet its requirements, that it is necessary only to state the speciality they wish to take to. If officers apply for more than one speciality separate applications should be forwarded. Applications will not be acknowledged.

Officers should note to strictly comply with the instructions contained in the preceding paragraph.

Officers who have been recruited for permanent service as Medical Officers of Health are eligible to apply for study leave only for Public Health
