#### GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

**Allowances.**—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

**Conditions of Service.**—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

**Terms of Engagement.**—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay), appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

**Qualifications required.**—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese.

A “Ceylonese” is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

**War Service Concession.**—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service (commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest), from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

**Other Requirements.**—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

**THE CEYLON CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

THE Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Ordinance 1895 as amended by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Amendment Ordinance 1932

With reference to the Rules of the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce and relative appendices published on pages 1932 e' seq of Part I of the Ceylon Government Gazette No. 8,024 dated December 22, 1933, it is hereby notified that at an Annual General Meeting of the Chamber duly convened and held at their rooms on Tuesday, March 23, 1954, —

1. *Bye-laws and conditions of sale of tea by Auction. Appendix B*

(a) Bye-law No. 5 was amended to read as follows with effect from the sale of October 12, 1953 :—

“ 18 packages comprising full or half chests of Tea and upwards shall constitute a large break, any smaller number being regarded as a small break but no break of less than 9 packages shall be catalogued ”

(b) Condition of sale No. 4 was amended to read —

“ All Teas shall be paid for on catalogued weights (less 6 lb sample allowances) on or before prompt day, which shall be six days from date of sale, Sun days and Bank Holidays excepted. On receipt of payment by the Seller or the Selling Broker there shall be issued to the Buyer a delivery order on the Seller and the Buyer shall thereupon take delivery at Seller's Stores. Should payment not be made before noon on prompt day the Seller shall have the right on giving notice in writing to the Buyer to re-sell the lot or lots at the risk of the Buyer, who shall be liable for any loss resulting from such re-sale, and the Buyer so defaulting shall also be precluded from bidding in auctions for a period of three months from the prompt day. If settlement of any loss resulting from such re-sale is not effected on or before the termination of the aforesaid period of three months, the Buyer shall be further precluded from bidding in auctions thereafter until such time as settlement is effected. Buyers of Tea shall take delivery of their purchases within twelve working days after prompt day The Tea notwithstanding the fact that it may have already been paid for, shall be at Seller's risk (to the amount of the contract value only) for two working days after prompt day, unless previously delivered, and thereafter (except in the case of any dispute or disagreement arising, in which event it shall remain at Seller's risk pending settlement of such dispute or disagreement) it may remain in Seller's

stores at Buyer's risk (except in the case of loss or damage to Tea by fire, which shall be at Seller's risk) for a further ten working days without any liability on the part of the Buyer for storage. If the Buyer shall not have taken delivery of Tea purchased by him within the period of twelve working days after prompt day, the Tea, so long as it remains in Seller's stores, shall be at Buyer's risk absolutely (except only in respect of loss or damage to Tea arising from the Seller's own negligence or wilful act) and he shall in addition pay the Seller storage charges calculated at six cents per day per full chest and four cents per day per half chest until he shall take delivery thereof. Provided that any payment by the Buyer to the Seller on account of storage charges as aforesaid shall not make the Seller liable in any way whatsoever for any loss or damage to Tea from whatever cause arising other than the Seller's own negligence or wilful act.”

If either party shall refuse or neglect to appoint an arbitrator within three days after the other party shall have appointed an arbitrator on his part and shall have served or posted, under registered cover, written notice requiring him to make such appointment, then the arbitrator appointed as aforesaid shall, at the request of the party appointing him, proceed to arbitrate on the matter in dispute as if he were an arbitrator appointed by both parties for that purpose.

“Export duty and cesses, if any, shall be paid by the Seller.”

(c) *Form of Coconut Oil Contract.* The title of this form was amended to read:—

“Form of Contract for the Sale of Coconut Oil in Cylinders and/or Drums—F. O. B. Terms.”

4. *Conditions of sale of Coconut Oil in bulk.*—The following additional conditions of sale were adopted:—

**Conditions of Sale of Coconut Oil in Bulk**

1. These conditions of sale shall apply to every contract relating to the sale or purchase of coconut oil entered into between a local seller and a local buyer direct or through a broker for delivery to the Colombo Port Commission Bulk Installation Tanks. Every such contract shall be substantially in Form A 1 or Form A 2 (as the case may be) contained in the Schedule hereto

2. Where a contract is entered into through a Broker, he shall declare in writing the names of the Seller and the Buyer to each other immediately the contract is made, and if the Broker fails to declare the name of either the Seller or the Buyer, the Broker shall be liable as principal and shall be bound by all the terms and conditions of the contract.

3. The Buyer shall arrange with the Bulk Installation authorities for the oil to be accepted within the period fixed by the contract and enabling delivery to commence not later than 10 days before the expiry of that period, and he shall notify the Seller when he has done so. When the coconut oil is duly delivered to the Bulk Installation Tanks the Buyer shall pay the Seller the full value of such delivery against the Seller surrendering the official receipts from the Bulk Installation showing the oil as having been delivered into the Buyer's name. 6. Should the Buyer fail to notify the Seller of arrangements permitting delivery into the tanks to commence not less than 10 days before the last date of the period stated in the contract, the Seller shall have the right to tender the oil and the Buyer shall then within 14 days from the date on which the tender was posted effect payment at Buyer's office of 90 per cent. of the value of the oil in exchange for a Store Warrant substantially in Form C contained in the Schedule hereto, duly endorsed by a member of the Colombo Exchange Banks Association or the Imperial Bank of India or the Bank of Ceylon, the balance to be paid after delivery to the Bulk Installation on the terms laid down in condition 3. Every tender shall be substantially in the Form B contained in the Schedule hereto and shall be sent to the Buyer by registered post.

7. All risks arising on coconut oil sold under this contract shall be the responsibility of the Seller until the oil is delivered into the Bulk Installation Tanks

The umpire shall then make his award after receiving the submissions of the two arbitrators. The award issued by a single arbitrator or jointly by two arbitrators or by

If either party shall refuse or neglect to nominate an arbitrator within three days after the other party has given written notice claiming arbitration and nominating his arbitrator, the arbitrator so nominated shall proceed with the arbitration as sole arbitrator and shall be deemed to have been nominated by both parties.

15. Arbitration awards shall stipulate the amount of the arbitration fees and by whom such fees shall be payable.

16. If before fulfilment of the contract either party shall be adjudicated insolvent or have proceedings taken by or against it for a winding up, then the other party shall be entitled forthwith to purchase or sell, as the case may be, a like quantity and quality of coconut oil against such party and to proceed as if such party were in default.
