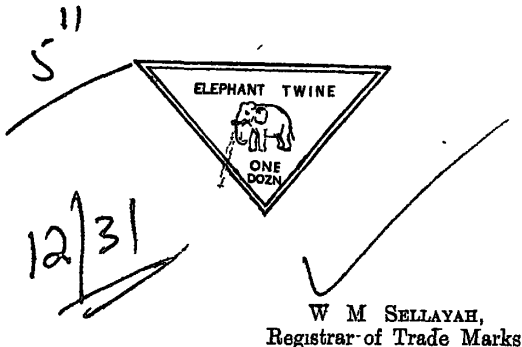

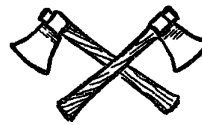

No. 4,003 of May 1, 1953. (*Convention application under section 48, claiming priority date, May 2, 1952*)

Coconut Processes, Inc.

"Method of extracting oil from mature, fresh coconut meats, other nut meats, seeds, beans, milk and the like"

*Abstract*—This invention relates principally to the extraction of coconut oil from mature, fresh coconut meat.

The nature of the invention may be ascertained from Claims 1 and 6 which read as follows:—

1. A method for the recovery of oils from oleaginous meats of nuts, beans, seeds and the like, which includes: pressing the meats to expel oily and aqueous phases as a liquid; centrifuging such liquid before fermentation to yield an oil-containing cream and an aqueous skim-milk; subjecting the centrifuged cream to enzymatic action without acid formation to break the oil emulsion present and yield an oil phase and an aqueous phase, and centrifuging the enzyme-affected cream to separate the oil phase.

6 A method for the recovery of coconut oil including: pressing coconut meat to expel the oil and aqueous phases thereof as a liquid; centrifuging such liquid, prior to fermentation, to yield an aqueous phase and a cream containing the oil; subjecting the centrifuged cream without fermentation to chilling temperatures of about 30°F to 50°F. to solidify the cream; melting the solidified cream within a temperature range between about 80°F and about 120°F. to produce high enzyme activity and release the oil; centrifuging the melted enzyme-affected cream to separate the released oil from aqueous and protein phases; and recovering the oil product.

The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1 A method for measuring play in a transmission, characterized in that the output member of the transmission is fitted with, or firmly joined to, an indicating device, that the input member of the transmission is first caused to move in one direction until the indicating device gives an indication which occurs when the output member begins to move and thereupon caused to move in the opposite direction until the indication of the indicating device ceases and that the extent of the movement of the input member of the transmission is measured between the indication and the ceasing of the indication

*Abstract.*—The present invention relates to barrels of firearms. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1 and 2 which read as follows:—

2. A barrel according to Claim 1, characterized by the length of the said one part being the same or nearly the same as that of the casing or the increment of a cartridge rammed in the barrel.

*Abstract.*—This invention relates to delay blasting. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1 A method of firing a succession of shots by the firing of their corresponding electric detonators with a delay period between successive shots which comprises arranging that an electric firing current is passed through the fusehead of each succeeding detonator by way of an electrically actuatable delay switch which is interposed between it and its preceding detonator so as to permit the electric firing current to pass through said fusehead when a closed circuit is formed by the actuation of said switch.
